The services and functions of Melchizedek, the High Priest and His Order

Key Scripture:

"For it is evident that our Lord was descended from Judah, and in connection with that tribe Moses said nothing about priests.

This becomes even more evident when another priest arises in the likeness of Melchizedek,

who has become a priest, not on the basis of a legal requirement concerning bodily descent, but by the power of an indestructible life.

For it is witnessed of him, "You are a priest forever, after the order of Melchizedek."" (Heb 7:14-17)

Ps 110:1-7; Zech 6:12-13; Heb 6:20; ITim 2:5-6.

Christians and the Priesthood:

Because Christ is **High** Priest and serves at the helm of this **order** and because it is also called a Priest**hood**, this indicates that there are or will be others in junior roles serving in the Order.

It follows that we, as embryonic priests in the Order of Melchizedek, likewise suffer so that we are able to be empathetic and fully understanding of the humans we will be representing. See Rev 1:5-6; 5:9-10. Notice the priestly garments of the saints: Rev 3:4, 18; 6:11; 7:9; 19:7.
