the mistakes in the creed of the denomination and are trying to bring about reform. Hany of these reformers within the denomination are sympathetic with the Cathering Call because of the reform work it is doing.

The Gathering Call depends wholly on the Lord for financial support. It never makes calls for money. The work is supported by the personal efforts of its editor and the free will offerings of its friends.

It is recognized by its friends and its fees as the most potent reprover of the Seventh-day Adventist denomination in the field. It is continually gaining new recruits from all ranks of life.

The Gathering Call has never attempted to publish the facts at its command to the general public. It has confined its efforts to Seventh-day Adventists believers. This policy may be changed in the near future.
