Dear Ones of The Reporter Family,--

Greetings from Jerusalem. I am writing you this letter in the south part of Jerusalem about three miles from Bethlehem. The word "Bethlehem" is from two Hebrew words "beth" - house, and "Lahem" - bread. Our Messiah was born in Bethlehem, and He said of himself, "This is the bread that cometh down from heaven", John 6:50. It was thus foreordained that He should be born in Bethlehem.

We are having beautiful summer weather, and crops are thriving. No locusts again this year as usual. Whenever they get near, we always have a strong north-west wind drives them far away over in the Arab countries. There are now around a thousand Jewish immigrants arriving every week, but still there is not much unemployment. This is also very miraculous.

With Russia's assistance to the Arab nations, flying in thousands of tons of modern war material and also many soldiers there is an increase of border war, but not near Jerusalem. It is again miraculous how few Israel soldiers are killed, and how few bombs strike inside the border towns. Israel has lost less than a dozen planes since the miracle war of June 1967, while Egypt alone has had over a hundred shot down by Israel pilots. Russia's end is pre-announced in Ezekiel 38th chapter. The work of the Master is still going on good here, and orders continue to flow in daily for the New Testament. Many are being sent out, also Hebrew Bibles with both Testaments as well as many tracts. During May I spent a little over four thousand Israel pounds for postage alone. We thank and praise the Almighty for the chosen few over the world who are having a part with us in this preparation work here. Also for perfect health and strength to do our part in it. We rejoice to see Ezekiel 36; 24 to 27 etc. fulfilled before our eyes. The Jews all over Israel are praying for the Holy Spirit, and they will not ask in vain. Luke 11; 11 to 13.

My wife Effie joins in sending greetings and love to you and yours, hoping this finds all in the best of health.

Since writing this letter word has just come to us that the twenty thousand Hebrew Bibles with both testaments, ordered last fall printed at Tel Aviv will be delivered in about three weeks.

Dear Ones of The Reporter Family,--

Greetings from Jerusalem, hoping this will find you and yours well as it leaves us. We have had a wonderful winter so far, and it has only frosted three nights at Jerusalem, which is three thousand feet elevation, on Mt. Zion. We had three days rain in January, which was good for all the crops.

Egypt and the Arab nations refused to keep the cease fire agreement which they signed with Israel following the three days war in June 1967, so there is a minor war going on constantly along the borders, which is daily growing more serious. It is really miraculous how few lives are lost here. We see many reports printed in foreign papers, from the enemy which are absolutely false about destruction in Israel. Recently a general of the enemy army was captured, and he asked one of our officers why it was that their arm forces could not hit the targets, and the bombs and shells fall outside of the cities. The Israel general said,--"Our cities and border villages all have a wall of iron around them, and your shells and bombs cannot get through". It sure appears that way. Praise be to the "Holy One Of Israel", Psalms 89:18 and 78:41 Isaiah 5:19 -10; 20-12; 61:7; 7--12 and 31--1:54, 5-- and 60:14 etc.

The Jews scattered over the world for nearly two thousand years are now returning by the thousands every month. Nearly three million are here now. About fifty thousand came last year, and they expect many more this year. The prophecy of Christ ( Hebrew-Yahshua ), Luke 21:24 has been fulfilled, and now they return at these ending days of Gentile times, The wonderful prophecy of Ezekiel 36: 24 has also been fulfilled. The Almighty has brought them here. NOW it is for us to do the work of verse 25. This is the time for sprinkling the clean water the "WORD" upon them. Our beloved Messiah gave us the New Testament which He said was the "WATER" that would spring forth into life eternal. St. John 4:14, Eph. 5:26 etc. How amazing to be here and to see the hunger the Almighty is placing in the hearts of the Jewish people for the New Testament this precious "Water of Life". This winter cards and letters are coming in from Israel more than one hundred a day asking for the New Testament, or the Bible with both new and Old. One day last week over two hundred were received. During the month of January two thousand four hundred and ninety eight came in. These orders have all been filled, and sent out free. Besides these orders two weeks ago we received 208 cards and letters ordering the Book of Daniel in Hebrew also sent free. We have now printed 68 thousand of these much sought after books which were never permitted to be translated or printed into the Hebrew tongue. Therefore you will find most of Daniel in all Hebrew Bibles in the Aramaic tongue, but with Hebrew letters. The ancient radicals among Judaism pronouncing a curse upon anyone who would translate the book into Hebrew it seems has sealed it to the Jews as mentioned in Daniel 12:4 until this time of the end period when it says "Knowledge was to be increased".

Dispite this curse pronounced upon anyone who would translate this book into the Hebrew, or calculate the prophecy of the seventy weeks of the 9th chapter concerning the coming of the Messiah it has now been translated and printed into 68 thousand books, most of which have been sent out to all school teachers, government officers, and reading rooms of Israel. Instead of the curse, Praise the Heavenly Father it has brought blessings to many, and will bring blessings to many more, who are able to have a part in printing many more thousands soon to be needed as these orders are still coming in on every mail.

We have now on file over thirty thousand names of mostly young people in Israel who have written in to Jerusalem for the New Testament, or Bibles with both Testaments. All were supplied free. How wonderful this pure "WATER", that is to spring forth unto life eternal is being sprinkled on these incoming exiles, as they come here from more than eighty four countries. The Almighty is laying it upon their hearts to return. That is His work. Now man's work is to provide them with this "Water of life" without price.

The 24th verse of this 36th chapter of Ezekiel is for the Heavenly Father to do, but verse 25 is our work together. Then verses 26, 27, 28 is His work. We cannot take away their stony hearts and give them hearts of flesh. Neither can you or me or anyone put the Holy Spirit into their hearts, as these verses tell us will be done. This is the Almighty's work, and it is being done now to some extent. This work is beginning, but before this after they come, the "WORD" is to be given them. Only one verse here is man's work to do, verse 25. Let us do it with sacrifice and joy in our hearts, and receive the blessing promised to all who bless Israel. Genesis 12; 2, 3. May all who read this offer up a prayer for Israel, and for this work.

Israel is calling now for the book of Revelation in the Hebrew, with explanations, and we have it mostly prepared now for printing. This will also be of great help to them, in showing them their Messiah, and that He is soon to return. Most of them never heard his name mentioned in their life, and never knew there was such a book as the New Testament.

The work in Israel is yet an open door, and a wonderful opportunity for investment in a soul saving work that will bring in a hundred fold for the kingdom, and blessings to all who can have a part in it.

We wish to express our heart felt thanks for the part that a few who read this have had with us in the work here to which the Heavenly Father has definitely called us.

May heaven's choice blessings richly abide with every one who reads this letter is our wish and prayer. My wife and the Reporter staff join sending greetings and love to you one and all.
