



THE HISTORY OF THE TRUE FAITH

It is a well known fact to all who have read the Holy Scriptures that the "Chosen People," blessed and led of Heaven, are known as "ISRAEL." How they were miraculously led from Egypt through the wilderness and into the promised land is familiar history.

The Prophet Isaiah informed us in advance that the name Israel was to be changed. He said of the Jews that they would be removed into far countries. Also he said, "Their seed shall be known among the Gentiles . . . and all that see them shall acknowledge them, that they are the seed which the LORD hath blessed". Isa. 61:9. Then in the following chapter (62:2), He says, "And thou shalt be called by a NEW NAME, which the MOUTH of the LORD shall name". Then a little farther on in chapter 65:12-15. He says, "There-



fore I will number you to the sword, and ye shall all bow down to the slaughter. Because when I called you did not answer, and when I spoke you did not hear, but did evil before mine eyes . . . And ye shall leave your name for a curse unto my chosen, for the Lord shall slay thee, and call HIS SERVANTS BY ANOTHER name".

**THE NEW NAME**

Was to be given WHEN the Gentiles received the Word, Isa. 62:2.

Was to be given by the mouth of the Lord. Isa. 62:2.

Was to be given to HIS SERVANTS. Isa. 65:15.

Was to be given after the Messiah came, and Israel was scattered and punished, Isaiah 65:9 to 15. The Messiah was this inheritor. Verse 9. He came from the seed of Jacob.

**NAME GIVEN PROPHECY FULFILLED**

This inheritor came forth from Judah and was born in Bethlehem Micah 5:2. Then the Jews were given up. Verse 3. He was and is the son of the Heavenly Father. Isa. 7:14, also 9:6, 7, and 11:1, and 53rd chapter. He is the Lord Jesus (Yahshua), and he gave the NEW NAME to the church. Note the words of the prophet, — The mouth of the Lord shall give the new name, Isa. 62:2. He gave the new name. Read John 17:6, 11, 12, and 16, where he repeatedly informs us that he gave the name of the Father for the church. The reason is very simple indeed, that the children of this one family are to be given the name of their Father. The apostle Paul understood this when he said, "I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ of Whom the whole family in heaven and earth "Is named." Ephesians 3:14, 15. How wonderfully was this prophecy fulfilled and the new name given, just 12 times in the New Testament. In English "The Church of God." The texts are as follows, I Cor. 12, and 10:32, also 11:16, 22, and 15:9. 2 Cor. 1:1, Gal. 1:13, I Thes. 2:14, 2 Thes. 1:4, Acts 20:28, and I Tim. 3, 5, 15. In the Hebrew New Testament it is Assembly, Congregation, or "Famiy of Elohim" (Hebrew, Kenesyah).

**FAITH AND DOCTRINE**

The Messiah called unto himself 12 apostles. (Luke 6: 14-16) and taught them for three years and a half, until He, as the Lamb was sacrificed on the cross, Isa. 53, and Heb. 9:22 and chapter 10. Then after his ascension the Spirit was sent forth to the apostles and they gave us the New Testa-

ment. In it the Ten commandments are repeatedly spoken of and emphasized as the standard of right and wrong, but the transgressors receive justification and pardon by the shed blood of the Messiah instead of by the old system of pardon given by Moses. This old pardon law by the animal sacrifice is stoutly condemned throughout the New Testament, and spoken of as the law of bondage, given only until the seed should come which was the Messiah. Gal. 3:19. Paul's conclusion after giving a discussion of the law is, — "Do we then make void the law through faith. God forbid, yea we establish the law." Rom. 3:31.

**THE NEW TESTAMENT LAW & COMMANDMENTS**

Salvation does not come to people through the keeping of any law, but only through the power of the Holy Spirit, drawing the sinner to repentance, changing and regenerating his heart, sanctifying and causing a complete separation from the world for service. Then through the Word, the will of God is revealed, and he will walk in the light of truth. John says, "But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ, his son cleanseth us from all sin". I John 1:7. Note carefully also in the next chapter just a few verses on, we are told to keep the commandments, Chapter 2:3, 5, and also that sin is the transgression of the law Chapter 3:4. The power of the Holy Spirit in the life gives us overcoming victory, so we can crucify the flesh and keep the commandments.

The natural man cannot keep the law, for the law, Paul tells us, "Is Holy, Just and Good". Rom. 7:12. This is why we are told that only through the power of the Spirit, can we be obedient servants. Romans 8:7.

Please notice the following scripture, — Matt. 5:17-19, and 7:21 to 23. Romans 2: 13, and 3:31, also 7:12, 22, Rom. 8:7, I Cor. 7:19, I John 2:3, 4, and 3:4, also 5:3. Rev. 12:17 and 14:12, also 22:14.

**HISTORY OF THE CHURCH**

All of the congregations in Judaea in the days of the early church were known as — "The churches of God", (Kenesyah), — I Thes. 2:14. This name together with the creed or doctrine of the commandments and the faith of Jesus, (Hebrew Yahshua), has been preserved down through history unto the present time, and the same body with the same faith still exists to-day. It is also restored back to Jerusalem

and the Holy Land from whence it sprang nearly two thousand years ago, and remained until 70 A.D. Then the members fled with the Jews at the time of the Roman invasion. Now as the Jews have returned, the same church with the same doctrine has returned, with them.

In speaking of the church in Palestine at that time, "Hue Smith's Church History" says, "The church escaped the horrors of the siege of Jerusalem by following the warning of Christ (Matt. 24) and fleeing to the mountains beyond the Jordan. This timely retreat was made to the small town of Pella."

We read in the book, "Hulbert's Story of The Christian Church" — Pages 41 and 42, as follows, "From the utterances of Yahshua, the church received warning, escaping the doomed city found refuge at Pella in the Jordan valley".

In the history of the "Christian Church by Hugo" — Pages 50, and 51 we read, "The first fifteen Bishops of Jerusalem were all Jews excepting possibly one (ST. Mark), and the congregation over which they presided united the teachings of Moses with the doctrine of Christ."

In the "Anti-Nicean Fathers volume I we read," In the second century Ignatius wrote to Smyrnaeans thus, "To the Church of God in Smyrna" — Page 79. Also "The Church of God in Philadelphia." This was in the 4th century A.D.

We quote from "The International Standard Dictionary" recently purchased at Jerusalem, volume 3, Page 1613 as follows, "When Hadrian visited Jerusalem in 130 A.D. one of the few buildings left standing was the little "Church of God" on the site where the apostles returning after the ascension of the Saviour from Olivet had gone up to the upper room, for there it had been built, that is to say on the quarter of Zion."

We quote from the "Church History by Lewis" — page 8 as follows, "The ancient synod Laodicea made a decree against the Sabbath 321 A.D. (Chapter 29) Pope Gregory the great, affirmed that it was Judaizing."

From "Hulbert's Story of The Christian Church" page 45, we quote as follows, "As long as the church was mainly Jewish, the Hebrew Sabbath was kept, but as it became increasingly Gentile the first day gradually took the place of the seventh day."

In the "Ecclesiastical History" — Volume 1, chapter 2, Sec. 30, we read, "While the Jewish christians of Palestine retained the entire Mosaic law, and consequently the Jewish festivals, the Gentile Christians observed also the Sabbath and the Passover. I Cor. 5:6-8."

Another book, "Church History Apostolic Age to 70 A.D. by Lewis S and S" — Page 135 "While the Christians of Palestine who kept the whole Jewish law celebrated of course all the Jewish festivals, the heathen (Gentiles) converts observed only the Sabbath."

#### DR. ARIUS

Dr. Arius, the most talented and intellectual spiritual leader of the 4th century was a staunch observer of the 7th day Sabbath and observed the Lord's Supper at the time of the Jewish Passover on the 14th of the 1st month Abib. He also emphasized the power of the Holy Spirit in the life of the believer.

In the year 325 A.D. a general church council was called by Constantine, Emperor of Rome, to convene at Nicea, which 323 bishops attended, most of whom were from the Western Churches. Dr. Arius and his doctrine was the main topic for discussion, resulting in his banishment, together with other bishops on the islands of the sea. We find the following in "Whaley's Church History", page 37, published

by the Presbyterian board. "A dispute arose at an early period between the Eastern Asiatic (Jerusalem) churches, and the Western (Roman) churches over the time to celebrate the Passover. The Latin (Western) churches celebrated it on Sunday, the first Sunday after the 14th of the first month Abib. . . . This caused so much trouble between the East and the West, until it was finally settled at the council of Nicea in favor of the Latin Roman Church, A.D. 325.

We quote from—"Sermons on the Sabbath and Sacrament" — by William Jones, page 122, 123, "When the practice of keeping Sabbath which had become so general at the close of this century (the 4th), was evidently gaining ground in the Eastern churches a decree was passed at the council of Laodicea A.D. 364 that members of the church should not rest from work on the Sabbath."

We quote from, — "History of The First Century," — by Eusebius, written 1700 years ago, Page 243, Quote, "The Sabbath was not dropped by the church at Laodicea until the year 363." Page 88, he says, "The Jewish christians also observed the Sabbath."

We now quote from, "Ancient Christianity Exemplified," by Coleman. He says, The last day of the week was strictly kept a long time after the overthrow of the Temple, and even down to the fifth century." During the early age of the church it referring to the first day of the week), was never entitled the Sabbath. This word being confined to the seventh day of the week, the Jewish Sabbath, which as we have already said continued to be observed for several centuries by converts to Christianity. Chapter 6, Section 2.

We note that the Sabbath is called "The Jewish Sabbath" only by man, but no such reference is found in the Scriptures. It was observed by the Jews because they were God's chosen people. In the New Testament it is clearly set forth that this "Seventh Day Rest" is for the people of God. Hebrews 4:4-9.

That the Saviour was resurrected on the First Day, giving it the title "Lord's Day," is also a false teaching emanating from Rome, and does not harmonize with the scriptures, or agree with the only sign given by the Messiah, viz., that He would be in the grave THREE DAYS AND THREE NIGHTS. Matt. 12:40. This sign was most remarkably fulfilled. Send for free tract, "Three Days And Three Nights."

#### THE CHURCH FATHERS

There are two sets of church Fathers. One set stood for the Eastern churches of which Jerusalem was the headquarters, and Dr. Arius was with this group. The others stood for Rome and the Western bishops, and advocated Sunday keeping, infant baptism, and sprinkling for baptism, viz., Justin, Eusebius, Myrtyr, Jerome, Polycarp, Ignatius and others frequently quoted by Sunday keeping ministers.

The eastern or Ante-Nicean Fathers were decidedly against the Western Roman Bishops. There were 8 large books known as "The Ante-Nicean Fathers," which can be found in some of the second hand book stores. The writer has a set of these books. The Eastern bishops had their headquarters at Jerusalem, but of course, are never quoted in any of the hundreds of booklets published by the many "unlearned or unstable twisters of Paul's writings." II Peter 3:15,16, in their vain and empty efforts to establish Sunday for the Sabbath or day of rest. These men are still followers of the western Roman bishops. On the other hand the Eastern bishops known as anti-Nicean Fathers (against

# MEMORIES OF PAST EXPERIENCES IN THE GOSPEL WORK

In our last MEMORIES we told you of our arrival in Jerusalem, with my wife Effie and the three small children; of the printing press arriving from London; holding the seven weeks tent meeting; and of Brother Henry Cohen printing 150 thousand four page tracts in the Hebrew language.

Later, we will tell you of different experiences while distributing the tracts in the different settlements. The title "General Allenby and Jerusalem", attracted immediate attention and interest. It was shown how his conquest and capture of Jerusalem the year 1917 fulfilled Bible prophecy, especially that of the prophet Isaiah as follows, "So shall the Lord of Hosts come down to fight for Mount Zion and for the hills thereof. As birds flying, so will the Lord of Hosts defend Jerusalem, defending also He will deliver it, and passing over, He will preserve it." Isaiah 31:4, 5.

Attention was called, how General Allenby appealed three times to King George of England for advice because the Garrison and Turkish army in defense of the city warned him if he attacked, they would blow to bits all of the sacred sites. How on the last appeal King George told the general to pray about it. It was after he prayed that Allenby ordered 100 war planes loaded with T.N.T., (the most feared explosive of that time), to fly from the Egyptian air base over Jerusalem.

As these roaring planes came over the hills approaching the city the entire Turkish army fled in fright without firing a gun. Thus was the city delivered just as the prophet had pre-announced hundreds of years before.

It was also explained in these tracts, how prophetic time periods announced by Moses and Daniel expired the year 1917, and that other prophecies concerning the returning exile were just as sure to be fulfilled in the future. In these tracts we also calculated the prophetic time period of 70 weeks the 490 years, from the going forth of the commandment to build Jerusalem until the coming of the Messiah.

Our first trip in their distribution was in upper and lower Galilee where 75 thousand were distributed systematically in the different settlements, and we had some very wonderful experiences. One town we visited in the Jordan valley, the small children, believing we were common missionaries, began following us around and tearing up the tracts whenever they could get a hold of them. We had parked our car right in front of a large house where one of the tracts was left when first entering the town. It was only about half an hour afterwards that a large fine looking well dressed man about 60 came to where I was speaking to a few men; three or four blocks from his residence. He wanted all of us to come to his house. He said, "I want to have atalk with you". The invitation was accepted. We all gathered together and were very courteously treated. Inside the house we were seated around a long table in a large room, while he sat at the end. All of the children came filing in and lined up around the wall in a long line.

Picking up one of the tracts he said, "who is the writer of this"? He was informed that I was the writer. He said, "These prophecies are the same as my father taught me when I was a child at home in Russia," and I thought perhaps you knew my father, and had got this information

from him". I informed him that my father living in the U.S.A. had taught me these thing also when I was a boy, and I had remembered them since, but that my father could not have known his father. He said, "My father taught us that Jerusalem would be taken out of the hands of the Gentiles the year 1917, just as you have it in this tract, and that England would be the nation that would drive out the Turks, the leader in giving this country back to the Jewish people. Also that 1922 would be the probable year this would happen, the same as you have it in this tract".

We spent a few very peaceful and happy moments with him which have since been very pleasant memories of our stay in Jerusalem the year 1932. I told this man that we were in a hurry to go as we wanted to make it over to Tiberias in good time to find a location for the night and we would therefore need to leave him. He said, "I would like to get a Bible with both Testaments for my boy. That is him the tall one over in the corner standing along the wall." This boy, by the way had been the ring leader of the others in destroying the tracts. But after his father had entertained us with such a pleasant welcome, he followed me out to the car parked in front of the house, with all the other children following him. He asked me for one of the tracts, in turn so did all of the boys and girls. Each one went away reading it, or placing it firmly in a pocket. It was amusing to see how their attitude had so completely changed.

I told him I would purchase a bible at Jerusalem and send it to him, which I did soon after our return, a little over a week later, where-up-on he wrote me a very good letter of acknowledgement saying, "I am so glad you men came to our town. Your coming here is going to do much good."

the Nicean Conference), advocated the keeping of the true Sabbath as all of the foregoing historians have proven, and many more could be added.

They show conclusively how the Sabbath was kept strictly in all of the cities in the East, by both Jew and Gentile Christian down to 500 A.D. when the Pope at Rome became so universally strong that these churches were closed and (Judaizers referring to Sabbath keepers), were either banished or driven into exile far back into the mountain districts, and their wilderness experience began.

This disastrous climax to the long struggle between the East and the West, between truth and error, was revealed by our Saviour in advance of its coming, and the church was forewarned of this defeat. In the 12th chapter of Revelation verses 6 and 14, our Saviour said that this woman (a symbol of the church) would flee into the wilderness where the Lord would feed her for 1260 days (a day for a year), Ezek. 4:4,6. This period began the year 538 when the pope ascended to power, and church and state were united. It was to continue 1260 years reaching to the year 1798. Now notice verse 16 that the earth helped the woman, (the church), and we will notice later how the church fled to America at this very period.

Notice particularly verse 17 that the creed of the true REMNANT church is "The commandments of God, and the testimony of Yahshua." The same church having this same creed today is again being classed as Judaizers. There are over 500 sects among protestants known as Christian churches, who shun all of the scriptural texts given in this work on the law and the commandments of God, BECAUSE they fear being classed with the Judaizers, and shunned by the popular Sunday keeping world. Not one of these sects can qualify as the "Remnant" church against which the dragon is to make war. Rev. 12:17. They emphasize only the New Testament which contains the testimony of Jesus, and also the law of ten commandments found in many texts. The reason they do not also emphasize the ten commandments is because of the 4th which enjoins rest on the Seventh day instead of the first. The true church, however, is built on "THE APOSTLES AND THE PROPHETS," with Jesus Christ (Yahshua) Himself being the chief corner stone. Eph. 2:20. Our foundation and creed is both, with special emphasis on the need of the Holy Spirit, to enable us to keep all of the law of The Commandments, and the teachings of the Messiah.

As I looked from the great stone battlement surrounding the lower part of the mountain, I remember having heard that some pilgrims of long ago were supposed to have gone up there to scrape some tar off an old ship-wreck, to make good-luck emblems to wear around their necks to prevent their crops being destroyed by excessive rainfall. The legend further states that they left in haste after a bolt of lightning struck near them and they had never returned! Silly ancients! Whoever heard of a ship-wreck on a mountain top?

We traversed a couple of miles around the snow-capped dome and then took a long swift glide down the south side and suddenly came upon a perfect gem of a lake, blue as a sapphire, but frozen over on the shady side. Whilst we were circling around, suddenly my companion yelled and excitedly pointed to the overflow end of the lake. I looked and nearly fainted. A submarine? No it wasn't, for it had stubby masts and the top was rounded over with only a flat catwalk five feet down the length of it! But what a strange craft, built as though the designer had expected waves of water to roll over the top most of the time and had engineered it to wallow in the sea like a log with those stubby masts carrying enough sail to keep it facing the waves. (Years later in the great lakes I saw the famous whale-back ore carriers with the same kind of rounded deck).

We flew as close as safety permitted, and took several circles around it. We were surprised at the immense size of the thing, for it was as long as a city block and compared very favourably to the liners of today. It was grounded on the shore of the lake, with one-fourth under water. It was partly dismantled on one side near the front and on the other side was a great doorway nearly twenty feet square. This seemed quite out of proportion to modern ships which seldom have doors even half that size.

After seeing all we could from the air, we broke all speed records back to the airport. When we related our find, the laughter was loud and long. Some accused us of getting drunk on too much oxygen. The Captain, however was serious. He asked several questions and said: "Take me up there, I want to look at it!" We made the trip without incident and returned to the airport. "What do you make of it?" I asked as we climbed out of the plane. "Astounding!" he replied. "Do you know what that ship is?" "No!" I returned. "Ever hear of Noah's ark?" "Yes sir but I don't understand what that has to do with that strange thing 14,000 feet up on a mountain top." "That strange craft," explained the Captain, "is Noah's ark. I has been sitting there for nearly 5000 years. Being frozen up for nine of ten months of the year, it couldn't rot, and has been in cold storage all this time. You have made the most amazing discovery of the age!"

When the Captain sent a report to the Russian government, it caused considerable interest and the Czar sent out two companies of special soldiers to climb the mountain. One group of fifty men attacked one side, whilst a hundred men attacked the other. Two weeks of hard work were n

quired to chop out a trail and it was nearly a month before the Ark was reached. Complete measurements were taken, plans were drawn of it and many photographs obtained, which were all sent to the Czar. The Ark was found to contain hundreds of small rooms, whilst others were large with high ceilings. The unusually large rooms had a fence of great timbers as though designed to hold beasts ten times the size of elephants. Other rooms were lined with tiers of cages, somewhat like one sees today at a poultry show: only instead of chicken wire they had rows of tiny iron bars along the front.

Everything was heavily painted with a wax-like material resembling shellac, whilst the workmanship showed all the signs of a high type of civilization. The wood used was oleander, which belongs to the cypress family which never rots. This, together with the intense cold, accounted for its perfect preservation. The expedition also found on a peak of the mountain above the Ark, the burned remains of the wood observed to be missing from the Ark. Evidently those timbers were hauled up and used to build a shrine, for inside was a rough stone altar, such as the Hebrews use for sacrifices. That timber had either been struck by lightning, or it had caught alight through a fire from the altar. The timbers were considerably charred and the roof burned entirely away.

A few days after the report had been sent to Russia, that government was overthrown by the Bolsheviks. Our records were probably destroyed by a set of men who sought to discredit religion and all belief in the Bible. Meanwhile, we White Russians of the Air Fleet escaped through Armenia. Four of us eventually reached America, where we could be free to live accordng to the Good Old Book, which we had seen for ourselves to be absolutely true, even to so fantastic sounding a thing as a world flood!

## HALF AS OLD AS TIME

### Rose-Red Petra Was Rediscovered 150 years Today

It is exactly 150 years ago that Petra, "the rose-red city half as old as time," was rediscovered by the Swiss-born explorer John Lewis Burckhardt.

On August 22, 1812, Burckhardt wrote in his diary: ". . . future travellers will visit the spot under the protection of armed forces; the inhabitants will become more accustomed to the researches of strangers, and the antiquities of Wadi Moussa will then be found to rank along the most curious remains of ancient art . . ."

The name Wadi Moussa recalls the road of the children of Israel in the desert. Aharon died in these parts and his tomb on Mount Hor has always been held in high esteem by the local population. However, Burckhardt refers here to ancient Petra which emerged into history in the Fourth century B.C.E. as the capital of the Nabateans. Situated about half-way between the southern tip of the Dead Sea and the Gulf of Akaba among the cliffs and mountains forming the eastern bank of Wadi Araba, this natural stronghold dominated the caravan routes which led from Leuce-Come, on the Red Sea, to Egypt and Syria.

Petra was absorbed into the Roman Empire's Provincia Arabia in the second century C.E. and was a bishop's seat in Byzantine times, but its wealth and power declined as trade passed into the hands of her rival Palmyra.

### Crusader Fortress

The Crusaders once more turned Petra into a fortress and erected a look-out post near Akaba, thereby driving a wedge between Egypt and the eastern Moslem states. Yet, after the fall of the kingdom of Jerusalem, Petra sank into complete oblivion as far as western geographical knowledge was concerned. Not more than a few days' ride from Jerusalem and Gaza, Petra remained inaccessible as no European traveler ventured beyond the Dead Sea.

In the summer of 1812, Burckhardt, in the service of an association for promoting discoveries in the interior of Africa, set out from Damascus to explore the country between the Dead Sea and the Gulf of Akaba. Thoroughly acquainted with the Arabic language and the eastern way of life, he had embraced Islam and could safely travel in Arab disguise.

The original assignment conferred upon him by the African Society, an investigation into the sources of the Niger, had proved impracticable and so the the traveller employed his time and experience exploring hitherto unknown parts of Syria, Palestine and Sinai, including a pilgrimage to Mecca.

### Arab Disguise

Dressed as a simple Arab townsman he rode in easy stages through Tiberias, Safad, Es Salt, Amman and Kerak. Following the continuation of the Jordan valley south of the Dead Sea, he wound up at the village of Eldjy, which brought him within a few miles of his goal.

He hired one of the villagers as a guide to Mount Hor, allegedly as he had vowed to slaughter a goat in honor of the local saint, aware that the way to the shrine led past

# THE ATOM BOMB FALLOUT

## ISAIAH TELLS US WHY THIS CONDITION IS PERMITTED.

"The earth is defiled under the inhabitants thereof, **BECAUSE** they have transgressed the laws, changed the ordinance, and broken the everlasting covenant. Therefore hath the curse devoured the earth, and they that dwell therein are desolate. Therefore the inhabitants of the earth are **BURNED** and **FEW MEN LEFT.**" Isaiah 24:5, 6.

## WHEN DOES A NATURAL JEW CEASE to be a JEW?

According to the law of Israel established by the Kenneset about three years ago, when a person declared himself to be a Jew, his identity card is to be made out as a Jew. Therefore, that is the legal civil statute of Israel, even though the extreme Orthodox do not recognize it. Because of these two conflicting opinions the subject has undergone much discussion in Israel. # Unity Plea at Vatican Parley

VATICAN CITY. — Pope John opened the Roman Catholic Church's Ecumenical Council in the splendours of St. Peter's here and told the 2,500 prelates assembled before him that they must "work actively" for Christian unity.

In his speech, made in Latin, the Pope said the new conditions of modern life had certain advantages and declared: "We feel we must disagree with those prophets of gloom who are always forecasting disaster, as though the end of the world were at hand."

The 80-year-old Pontiff in embroidered white cape and golden gem-studded mitre was carried shoulder-high on a portable throne from his place to the Basilica. Under his canopy, flanked by tall ostrich-feather fans, he made the sign of the cross repeatedly over the crowds.

He prayed in a loud, firm voice above St. Peter's Tomb under the high dome, and then was enthroned on a dais where mass was celebrated.

## MOSCOW URGES CHURCH ACTION FOR PEACE

MOSCOW. — The Soviet news agency Tass said that concrete steps designed to promote understanding in the world, the liquidation of the cold war, and the achievement of mankind's age-long dream of universal disarmament, peace and fraternity were the most important questions before the Vatican Ecumenical Council.

Commenting on "this most competent meeting of leaders of the Catholic Church," Tass recalled that Pope John had on numerous occasions spoken for peace, against the nuclear arms race and for the settlement of controversial international questions by negotiation.

Remarks: - This Ecumenical gathering of the Roman Catholic Church, and her prodigal daughter's at the so-called Holy City Rome is highly significant.

It is an unmistakable fulfillment of Bible prophecy, that just such would occur in the very last days of "Gentile Times," foreshadowing the universal peace cry that preceded destruction. I Thes. 5:1-5. These are the words of one of the prophets of doom condemned by the Pope. Jeremiah was another. Jer. 25:31 to 36, See also Isaiah 24, and Zephaniah 1:14 to 18, and 2:1, 2.

## BOOK ON SPELLMAN TELLS RELATIONS WITH THE VATICAN

WASHINGTON—A new book has just been published which will certainly be widely talked about wherever the influence of religious groups in politics is discussed. It is an authorized biography of Cardinal Spellman. It tells for the first time how relations were resumed in 1939 between the White House and the Vatican. It covers a period of ten years during which the late Myron C. Taylor, formerly head of the U.S. Steel Corp., served as the personal envoy of the President of the United States to Pope Pius XII. Mr. Taylor, who had been appointed by President Franklin D. Roosevelt, submitted his resignation to President Truman in 1950.

The intimacy portrayed between the Vatican and President Roosevelt will doubtless cause some Catholic publications to repeat recent comments that a President who is

Liver Damage Caused By Die (Cont. From Last Issue)

## Dangerous Double-Talk

Two other aspects of this bureaucratic mishmash show the need for an immediate impartial investigation by Congress, the President, or both.

First, the public has no way of knowing what foods and other products contain FD&C Red No. 1. The poison is used to give an appetizing color to such foods as frankfurters, ice cream, soft drinks, cake frosting and maraschino cherries. But these products are not labeled as containing this particular additive. Present federal law requires only that the words "artificial color" be on the label—regardless of what specific dye is used.

Second—and even more serious—is the fact that the government agency still permits use of four other dyes, each branded as potentially damaging by its own top cancer expert.

This is comparable to the reception which the Food and Drug Administration gave to many of this magazine's disclosures over the past five years—disclosures which the agency now admits were true. When our readers wrote their Congressmen to ask about specific revelation published in this magazine, the Representatives queried the Food and Drug Administration.

The agency wrote back to these Congressmen that these disclosures had no basis. This despite the fact that the government's own cancer expert, Dr. W. C. Hueper, chief of the Environmental Cancer Station of the National Cancer Institute, drew up a list of 29 food dyes in 1957 which he labeled "unsuitable or potentially dangerous which should not be added to food or drink for man or animals."

The Institute, like the Food and Drug Administration, is an arm of the Department of Health, Education and Welfare. Even though Dr. Hueper's list was drawn up several years ago, the following dyes on his list are still in use today:

FD&C Green No.1 — Used to color cordials, jellies, soft drinks, candy, bakery goods and frozen deserts.

FD&C Green No.2 — Used to color candies, essences, cordials, biscuits, cakes, jellies, fruit and frozen desserts.

FD&C Green No. 3 — Used to color candies, desserts, jellies, cakes and a wide variety of other bakery products.

FD&C Blue No. 1 — Used to color icings, cordials, extracts, jellies, ice cream, ice cream toppings, milk bar syrups candies, cake decoration, frozen desserts, bakery goods, and solutions for home use.

Dr. Hueper has stated bluntly: "... existence of cancer hazards in foodstuffs poses a serious problem, since daily and lifelong exposure to such agents would represent one of the most important sources of contact with carcinogens (cancer producers) for the population . . ."

The Food and Drug Administration admits that its experiments with FD&C Red No. 1 included one test in which the scientists gave 100 mice diets containing 1 percent of the poison. They died before the 70th week of the experiment. In tests where minute amounts were fed to animals, gross liver damage was observed in all of them.

The results can be directly related to the effects of poisonous dyes on human beings, according to experts.

A few years ago, for example, another coal tar color was

under investigation and a number of volunteers undertook the roles of human guinea pigs. The dye was used in candy. Dr. Bert J. Vos, assistant chief of the Division of Pharmacology of the Food and Drug Administration, tells what happened next:

"When the candy was tested on human volunteers, of which I was one, there was produced a marked abdominal griping and diarrhea.

"In my own case the results were obtained with six or eight pieces of candy. In some of the other volunteers who ate the candy, four pieces caused diarrhea and in one person diarrhea was produced by one piece of candy.

"We gradually narrowed the cause down to the coal tar dyes which were used to color the candies."

Many of the poisonous dyes have been in use for more than 21 years. The frightful increase in cancer, heart disease, and kidney and liver ailments in that period has been related by outstanding medical experts to the uncontrolled use of the additives.

What pressures have been exerted on the government to keep these dyes on the market?

This should be one of the first questions asked by Congressional probers of the food dye scandal. And Congressmen should also demand an answer to this one.

Why was no limit ever placed on the quantity of dyes such as FD&C No.1 used in specific foods?

Until it was finally banned altogether, FD&C No. 1 was authorized for unlimited use in foods. The amount of the dye used in each food item was left to the discretion of the manufacturer.

Thousands of tons of food contaminated with this poison are still somewhere in the pipeline between the processor and the consumer. The Food and Drug Administration says that an ordinary serving of one or two frankfurters, for example, would not contain enough of the poison to do serious harm. But how about the cumulative effect on a person who eats a dozen or more artificially dyed items a day, for a period of weeks or months?

## Consumers as Guinea Pigs

How much dye must you consume to develop cancer?

Despite all the food industry propaganda to the effect that you would have to eat tons and tons of some given item to be hurt, here's what Secretary Arthur S. Fleming of the Department of Health, Education and Welfare said in a letter to the American Medical Association:

"If a substance induces cancer when included in the diet of test animals, no one knows how much or how little of that substance will induce cancer if included in the human diet.

"Therefore, even though there may be some conflict of opinion on the part of scientists as to a substance causing cancer, the consumer should not be asked to serve as a guinea pig while the conflict is being resolved."

Fleming's words underscore the need for immediate action on this magazine's demand that all potentially dangerous dyes be taken off the market at once, and kept off until they are proved safe.

ancient Petra.

This precaution had to be taken in view of the superstitious belief held by the local people that treasures lay hidden in ancient monuments which strangers came to lift with the help of their magic books.

Ascending through the canyon of the Sky, which gives access to the site of the former city, the explorer beheld in admiration, tombs and niches carved into the sheer cliffs; ornaments and pilasters vying with the bizarre, eroded shapes of the rocks above. He walked furtively among tombs, temples and a theatre, discerning the impact of many cultural influences, from Egyptian to Greco Roman. Despite the ravages of time and wanton destruction, the monuments displayed traces of fine workmanship and reflected the very high standard of material culture enjoyed by their inhabitants and builders.

Afraid that close scrutiny might arouse the suspicion of his guide, whom he paid two horseshoes for his services, Burckhardt could not afford to spend more than one exhausting and exhilarating day among his discoveries. With the modesty of the true man of learning, he just inferred that he had probably found Petra, as no other place in the surrounding country answered the descriptions of Strabo and Pliny.

It took many decades until European governments and institutions sent out to Petra well-equipped and well-protected scientific missions who, in the true sense of the word, left no stone unturned. With the opening of the Hejaz railway, the country became more accessible to the ordinary traveller and the tourist guide took over where the scholar left.

Today, a motor runs along the valley where lonely Burckhardt jogged along on his miserable mare, and Petra is the lodestar of many a tourist. The Jordanian Government intended to commemorate the 150th anniversary of the discovery of one of its main attractions with a festival to be held in the ancient theater. But the celebrations are apparently to be postponed until next spring for technical reasons, or, maybe for climatic ones, as already Burck-

hardt had complained of the excessive heat generated by the summer sun beating down on the rose-red rocks.

## JERUSALEM AND ZION

"Behold, the Lord hath proclaimed unto the end of the world, Say ye to the daughter of Zion, Behold, thy salvation cometh; behold, His reward is with Him, and His work before Him."

"And they shall call them, The holy people, (This is not true of us today, but then we will be called a holy people.) The redeemed of the Lord:" and it is through the blood of the Son of God that we are redeemed: "and thou shalt be called, Sought out, A city not forsaken."

Today you are being sought out, the Lord is pleading with you through His Truth. He is seeking you out that you might not be forsaken. Come to Him through His Truth, for God says, "Why will ye die, O house of Israel?"

Turning to Hosea chapter 14— one of the most encouraging chapters in the Bible—we shall commence reading verse 1 wherein the Lord makes this plea to us:

"O Israel, return unto the Lord thy God; for thou hast fallen by thine iniquity. Take with you words and turn to the Lord; say unto Him, Take away all iniquity, and receive us graciously: so will we render the calves of our lips." And so will we give Thee praise.

# Feast of Tabernacles at Jerusalem

The "Feast of Tabernacles" at Jerusalem this year reminded us of the millennium, when we are told that every nation in the world will honor this gathering, and those who do not, will be smitten with a plague, or have no rain. See Zechariah 14th chapter. Verse 9 says, "The Lord shall be king over all the earth," in this day.

It made us think joyfully of this wonderful peace age because people from all over the world came to Jerusalem this year by ship and by plane. They poured in to Israel for weeks preceding the Tabernacle period, and best of all most of them came to our camp- and Tabernacle grounds, which is at the place of the Temple or church and guest house. There were several booths erected, and meals were served free cafeteria style.

Our temple of worship is located at the very best place in all of Israel to draw the tourists to us. It is the only place where they can get a good look over into the Arab country known as Jordan, the "Tourist Look out Point." All tourist companies bring their guests here to see the Old City, the Mount of Olives, Valley of Hinnom, Mosque of Omar, Jordan Valley and Dead Sea.

We did not begin counting the large tourist Buses, Taxis, and cars that came each day to look over to the other side, until Tuesday of the first week of the camp-meeting. Brother Harry Maurer was chosen to keep the big literature rack just outside the gate filled, and to count the buses and car. The following is his record each day beginning Tuesday, October 16th, after three days had passed. The literature rack, however, had been supplied before this.

Tuesday, there were 13 buses, six scooters. Twelve people went into the Temple.

Wednesday, 12 buses, 19 taxis, 24 private cars, six trucks, 4 scooters. Of these 12 people went into the Temple.

Thursday, 6 buses, 11 taxis, 15 private cars, six trucks, one scooter, and ten people went into the Temple.

Friday, (preparation day) three buses, 14 taxis, sixteen private cars, 1 truck, 3 scooters, and nine people went into the Temple.

Sabbath, one bus, 13 taxis, 15 private cars, one truck, nine scooters, and 24 people went into the Temple.

Total 47 buses, 56 taxis, 70 private cars, 14 trucks, 23 scooters. 67 people went into the Temple.

Besides these there were 142 people attended all or part of the meetings at different services.

There was also a constant stream of people walking from the city each day that were not counted. Hundreds of

these sight seers took literature from the rack outside.

The last day of the camp-meeting, a group of young men, from the Hebrew University came, and said they wanted a copy of every tract and booklet we had, as they wanted to study the Bible. Each one went away well supplied. The University is a school of liberal thought where they teach the New Testament in one Dept., and a number of leaders, it is said, are believing Jews. One we know of who has written a very strong work in defense of Yahshua being the promised Messiah to Israel, in answer to a leading critic. This manuscript has been turned over to our Hebrew Dept. Thus an outstanding and all important subject has become

# NEWS FROM ISRAEL

## FOUR ATTACKS FROM SYRIA

An exchange of fire lasting more than an hour took place on the Syrian border near Kibbutz Katzir yesterday afternoon.

The Syrians opened fire at a tractor driver working in the neighboring fields of Kibbutz Ha'On. The man had suspended work that morning because of earlier outbreaks of shooting. The firing lasted for only a few minutes, but commenced again at 6:10 p.m. This time Israel troops replied and a brisk, hour-long exchange, took place.

The tractor driver continued with his work throughout the firing. There were no casualties, although the Syrian tracer bullets caused a fire in one of the Kibbutz fields.

Earlier in the day, Syrians directed fire at Israel territory twice within 15 minutes. No one was injured and fire was not returned.

At 7:05 a.m., Syrians opened machinegun and mortar fire at a lake patrol boat making a routine tour along the east bank of Lake Kinneret. The vessel suffered no damage.

Fifteen minutes later, machinegun fire was opened at the Ha'On tractor.

In both cases, fire was brief but heavy.

Israel has submitted a strong complaint to the Mixed Armistice Commission.

## WORLD HEBREW UNION CONGRESS NEXT WEEK

TEL AVIV. — Acting President Kadish Luz and Prime Minister Ben-Gurion will address the opening session of the Third Congress of the World Hebrew Union at the Hebrew University's Wise Auditorium in Jerusalem next Monday.

Mr. L. Kuperstein, Chairman of the Union's Israel Council, told a press conference at Beit Sokolow here yesterday that some 250 delegates are expected — including 150 representing Union chapters in 15 foreign countries and 30 representing youth movements throughout the world.

## FIVE SOVIET CHURCHES JOIN WORLD COUNCIL

PARIS. — Five churches from the Soviet Union yesterday became members of the World Council of Churches, when the Council's policy-making body, the Central Committee, accepted their request for admission.

The five churches are: Union of Evangelical Christian Baptists of the Soviet Union, Georgian Orthodox Church, Estonian Lutheran Church, Evangelical Lutheran Church of Latvia, and the Armenian Apostolic Church.

## WEDDING POSTPONED BECAUSE GROOM MEMBER OF BNEI ISRAEL

### Pardess Hana Rabbi Refuses Registration

Printed invitations were sent out for a wedding for August 15, in Pardess Hana, but the wedding did not take place because the local rabbi refused to register the couple, one of whom was a Bnei Israel, a spokesman of the community's action committee told *The Jerusalem Post*.

Just back from Pardess Hana, and displaying an invitation, the spokesman reported that a few days before the scheduled marriage between Miss Ruhama Sasson, of Pardess Hana, a member of the Baghdadi community, who

came to Israel 11 years ago from Calcutta, and Mr. Aharon Shapukar, of Beersheba, five years here and of the Bombay Bnei Israel, the local rabbi, Rabbi Zalman Diskin, notified the prospective bride that he would not marry them.

He advised the couple to get married in Beersheba, as in any case they intended to live there, it was said. According to Miss Sasson, Rabbi Diskin had previously agreed to marry them.

### September 19 Date

The couple have set September 19 for the wedding, but insist on having it in Pardess Hana. A few days ago, it was said, Miss Sasson and relatives again went to Rabbi Diskin, and he again refused.

Rabbi Diskin, in 1958, sparked a Government crisis when he refused to bury the body of Aharon Steinberg, child of a mixed marriage, in the local cemetery.

## MORE REMAINS OF SHECHEM FOUND BY U.S. ARCHAEOLOGISTS

AMMAN. — American archaeologists have made fresh discoveries at the site of the ancient Biblical city of Shechem, a religious center dating back nearly to 2,000 B.C.E., the Jordan Antiquities Department announced yesterday.

The Department said the team — from the American school of Oriental Research in the Old City of Jerusalem — made a seven-week dig at the site, near Nablus, about 45 miles northwest of Amman.

Shechem is mentioned in Judges, chapter 9, as having been destroyed by Abimelech.

The excavators found a "great processional road leading from the lower city to the earliest temples... and a massive altar topped by huge flat stones."

One of the buildings was believed to be a shrine at which the Patriarch Abraham worshipped.

### Child's Grave

Under the floor of a "magnificent building, almost certainly the palace of the city," the excavators found the grave of a small child buried in a pottery jar, wearing a bead necklace and surrounded by funeral offerings in delicate pottery vessels.

### Cuneiform Script

Among finds was a small tablet inscribed in the cuneiform writing of the late Assyrian period. It bore a list of royal titles of an Assyrian deity, probably the sungod Shamash.

The Department announced that archaeologists from the Research School and from Pennsylvania University had made all other finds in the village of Gibeon, near Jerusalem. They included dwellings, a water well with pottery jars, and plates and spears in ancient graves, all dating to the Bronze Age.

## PRO-NAZI YOUTHS BEAT, BRAND ARGENTINE JEW

MONTEVIDEO. — Dr. Maximo Handel Blanc, an Argentine Jew, was beaten unconscious by four unidentified youths last night, bundled into a car and branded with swastikas on his thigh.

It was the third such incident in the past few days.

## ARAB BOYCOTT GROWING AGAINST U.S. FIRMS TRADING WITH ISRAEL

Surrounded by one-time Nazi big shots, armed with Soviet MIGs Gamel Abdul Nasser talks of "liberation" for the tiny state of Israel.

The United Arab Republic's loudmouthed, haw-nosed dictator now boasts a missile force all his own. He says that UAR rockets can hit any spot in Israel.

The U.S. State Department, however, plans no cutback in foreign aid for Nasser—and no action to break the Arab boycott.

The boycott is directed against U.S. firms said to have connections with Israel. I am in possession of a letter sent by the government of Kuwait's Israel boycott office to a New York firm. It reads in part:

"We have the honor to inform you that we have reliable information to the effect that you have dealings with Israel. Since the Arab States are still at war with Israel, no Arab merchant is allowed to have dealings whatsoever with Israel or any foreign person or company having certain relations with Israel. Any foreign country having certain definite relations with Israel is blacklisted in all the Arab countries."

On the blacklist: All U.S. firms that represent Israeli companies; that have branch factories or offices in Israel; that "render consultative services and technical experience to Israeli factories."

The list goes on and on. The Minnesota firm of Scherr-Tumico, Inc. recently received such a letter from Syria's boycott office. Howard James, president of the company, which makes mechanical, optical and electronic measuring devices, shot back:

"We are not impressed by your threats of intimidation and coercion through boycott and blacklist. If the Arab states had progressed industrially and scientifically to the point where your markets were lucrative for our products, we still would not be impressed.

Many companies—including Emerson Radio, General Tire and Rubber, Dow Chemical and Merritt-Capman and Scott—have refused to yield to the boycott and have lost their Arab markets.

Leading the fight in this country for stronger state department action against practitioners of the Arab boycott is New York Senator Jacob Javits.

The New York senator informs me that Assistant Secretary of State Phillips Talbot discussed the problem in detail with U.S. ambassadors to the Arab nations in an Athens conference last month.

"The discrimination, however, continues," says Javits.

Note: The Near East report says that the Arab boycott applies to people as well as goods. A group of five Americans who reached Jordan in June were expelled because they were "on the blacklist."

The reason: One member of the group, the Rev. R. E. Dawkins, of the Gospel Tabernacle in Kansas City, Kan., is editor of a religious weekly that is friendly to Israel.

### 1898: VISION OF FREE AFRICA

Theodor Herzl, seer of the Jewish State and founder of the Zionist Movement, incorporated his ideas in a political fantasy, "Altneuland" (Old-New Land), published in the year 1898, envisaging the State as an accomplished fact. Herzl's deep love of humanity is reflected in the following extract from his book:

"There is still one other question arising out of the disaster of the nations which remains unsolved to this day, whose profound tragedy only a Jew can comprehend. That

is the African tragedy question. Just call to mind all those terrible episodes of the slave trade, of human beings who merely because they were black were stolen like cattle, taken prisoner, captured and sold. Their children grew up in strange lands, the objects of contempt and hostility because their complexions were different. I am not ashamed

### DIMONA HAS HIGHEST BIRTHRATE IN ISRAEL

DIMONA. — The Local Council here is negotiating with Kupat Holim for the building of a maternity hospital in the town.

The Council Chairman, Mr. Armand Laredo, told the *Jerusalem Post* Dimona has the highest birth rate in the country—about four times higher than the average in the rest of the country.

to say, though I may expose myself to ridicule in saying so, that once I have witnessed the redemption of Israel, my people, I wish to assist in the redemption of the Africans."

### WHAT JEWISH CABALISTS SAY

Zerubabel Bar David, writing in UNITED ISRAEL BULLETIN, states: "In Jerusalem and in the heart of the Hassidic section of Brooklyn, pious, Einsteinian-like Cabalists (mystic interpreters of the Scriptures) are deeply stirred and moved over the results of the Cabalistic researches evolving from the study of the Zohar and other ancient works. All calculations, they stress, point to the fulfillment of all the prophecies relating to the coming of the Messiah, and the attending period, to this very age and time. The learned Cabalists, always supercautious in their statements, see the 60's as the decade of the prophetic materialization involving the Messianic rumblings.

### K SUGGESTS SMALL POWER TROOPS FOR BERLIN, SAYS WAR POSSIBLE

MOSCOW. — Mr. Khrushchev, in a two and one-half-hour speech to 2,000 international delegates in the Kremlin yesterday said: "The threat of a new world war really exists. Mankind may be drawn into it if determined measures are not taken." Never before had war preparations proceeded on so gigantic a scale.

Early in 1961 the first rocket was completed and the first launching took place in May last year. The magazine added that there were several launchings early in 1962 and Nasser declared that "this will be the surprise of the 10th anniversary."

According to official figures the world spends \$120,000m. on war needs every year.

"The Nato countries alone spend a million dollars every 10 minutes on war preparations."

In a world of international tension, even a simple mistake may cause the lightning-like chain reaction of universal war, he said.

### WATER DISCOVERED IN ARAD REGION

JEL AVIV. — The recent discovery of a well producing 2,400 cu.m. of fresh water a day has again raised the possibility of introducing agriculture in the development of the Arad Region, the Region Director, Mr. Yitzhak Pundik, told a Vocal Newspaper at Beit Sokolow on Friday night.

One more well of similar output would make farming a profitable proposition in Arad, he declared.

HASSOUNA CONFERRING ON SYRIAN COMPLAINT  
CAIRO. — Abdul Khalek Hassouna, Secretary-General of the Arab League, is at present holding a series of talks

with representatives of member states on the date and venue of the League Council meeting to consider the Syrian complaint against Egypt, claiming Abdul Nasser is interfering in Syrian internal affairs.

### U.S. GROUP TO INVEST \$10m. IN ASHKELON, ASHDOD HOUSING

#### Insurance Firms to Contribute \$4.5m.

A \$10m. investment programme sponsored by American Associates—a group of independent businessmen in the U.S. connected with property and finance—has been approved for the construction of 2,000 housing units in Ashkelon and Ashdod.

### ARABS TRYING TO AVOID UN DEBATE ON 'PALESTINE'

Arab delegations at U.N. Headquarters are making efforts to prevent discussion of the Palestine problem at the forthcoming General Assembly. The Old City daily "El Jihad" reported from Amman yesterday.

The daily, which is close to Jordan Government circles, said such efforts are being made because the importance of such a debate requires a unified Arab front to counter "Zionist efforts."

### INDUSTRIAL PROFITS DOUBLE IN FOUR YEARS

Industrial enterprises doubled their profitability in the years 1956/7 to 1960/1 — both in relation to their turnover and to their share capital.

This is the conclusion of a study on the financial structure of 1,618 industrial firms drawn up by the Bank of Israel and released on Friday.

### T.A. TO GET 40,000 MORE PHONE LINES

LYDDA AIRPORT. — Equipment for the installation of 40,000 new telephone lines in Tel Aviv and 20,000 for other parts of the country will be ordered abroad by the Director-General of the Ministry of Posts.

### IMMIGRATION LEADS TO LABOR SHORTAGE

Recent mass immigration, instead of giving rise to unemployment, actually creates a labor shortage, according to a Bank of Israel report released Friday.

The Bank's study of the effects of immigration shows that, under present conditions, the arrival of 10,000 immigrants in the country created a shortage of 5,200 workers in the first year after their arrival. The present full employment makes possible the rapid absorption of all new arrivals, who in turn serve to increase demand for services and goods.

### JERUSALEM REWARDS EFFICIENT STAFF

The Jerusalem Municipality yesterday awarded 46 efficiency prizes to its staff.

Eight persons received the first prize, a medal on a polished olive-wood stand; 21 the second prize, "Sefer Yerushalayim;" and 17 persons received letters of commendation.

Most of the prizes—34—went to members of the Water Department.

The awards were made by Mayor Mordechai Ish-Shalom, and Mr. M. Zar, head of the judges panel.

### 1,264 U.S. JEWS EMIGRATED TO ISRAEL LAST YEAR

NEW YORK. — The Jewish Agency announced recently that 1,264 American Jews emigrated to Israel from the United States during the past Jewish year. These immigrants included professionals who were processed through

Professional and Technical Workers Aliyah (PATWA), "hhalutzim" (pioneers) of the various Zionist youth movements, retired persons and middle class immigrants.

'CRITICAL' EGYPTIAN CURRENCY SITUATION  
LONDON. — A report in the "Financial Times" yesterday described Egypt's foreign exchange position as "critical."

It added it was unlikely that cotton could make its normal contribution next year to Egypt's foreign exchange which, it said, was "creaking under the strain of headlong industrialization."

### ANOTHER 70,000 TONS OF PHOSPHATES SOLD TO JAPAN

#### Shamir Pleads for Better Road to Eilat

TEL AVIV. — The Negev Phosphate Company will this week sign a new contract with the Brown-McFarlane Company of Tokyo for an additional 70,000 tons of phosphates worth \$1m.

This is the second order placed by Brown-McFarlane.

### ALGERIAN SITUATION UPSETS SHOFAR-MAKING HERE

HAIFA. — Israel's shofar maker, Mr. Meir Bar-Sheshet, will be leaving for Europe after the High Holidays to purchase rams' horns.

Mr. Bar-Sheshet told *The Jerusalem Post* yesterday that the uncertain conditions in Algeria had cut off his principal source of supply. Formerly he got the horns through a merchant in France.

He purchased a trial shipment from Australia, but the horns had been hacked off and were mostly too small for shofarot.

### TWO POLICE CHIEFS HELD FOR PINSK MASSACRES

FRANKFURT. — Four former members of the Nazi Security Service have been arrested on suspicion of murdering or aiding in the murder of thousands of Jews in the Nazi-occupied Eastern territories 20 years ago, the State Prosecutor's office announced here yesterday.

The four belonged to a police battalion which took part in the mass execution of inmates of the Jewish ghetto of Pinsk in the Soviet Union. Between 15,000 and 20,000 Jews were shot there in October and November 1942, the prosecutor's office said.

The four arrested men were named as former Lieutenant Josef Kuhr, 46, former first Lieutenant Heinrich Plantius, 47, former Captain Rudolf Eckert, 48, and Adolf Petsch, 57, former member of the Pinsk office of the Security Service.

Until their arrests, three of the four men held high posts. Kuhr was Chief Police Commissioner in Frankfurt, Eckert was Chief Police Commissioner in Hamburg and Plantius is a senior civil servant.

### IRAQ SAID RECEIVING SOVIET ROCKETS

PARIS. — Soviet ground-to-air rockets are arriving in Baghdad for a joint Soviet-Iraqi missile base which will be operational in a few weeks' time, "Paris-Presse" reported yesterday.

The newspaper's Middle East expert, Edouard Sablier, wrote that the bases were being built in the desert about 50 kilometres from the capital.

He said the bases were being constructed under an agreement by which Russia supplied equipment, instructors and personnel for the bases in exchange for military facilities.



## A RARE BEN-GURION

### Premier's Warmth and Wit Charmed Scandinavia

The man who occupied the entire Scandinavian press for almost four weeks, the man whose views abroad on crucial world problems are valued as those of an elder statesman of international stature, returned home this week on the eve of a New Year and his 76th birthday. On a trip all

the way to Scandinavia, Finland and Iceland it was easier to get to know the Prime Minister's personal views and attitudes, on big issues as on the small, than in Jerusalem. By the end of the tour a Rosh Hashana interview with the Prime Minister seemed quite superfluous, since there had been so many press conferences, personal talks with important Scandinavian leaders, informal talks with others. But from these a new image of the Prime Minister emerged, one unfortunately quite unknown to those who should know him best — the Israel public.

During these four weeks we often asked our colleagues in all five countries what really prompted them to give such unprecedented publicity to Mr. Ben-Gurion's visit, to Israel as such and to him as a person and a political figure. The answer was always the same: We followed what we knew was a public demand: to devote as much space as possible to one of the most popular foreign statesman to have visited our country.

Questioned further, our Scandinavian colleagues admitted that their real surprise and special incentive was the Prime Minister's human touch, his unexpected wit and humour, broad range of Knowledge, and keen interest and understanding in the problems of their respective countries. "He simply charmed his way into our readers' minds and hearts," was their comment.

The Israel journalists who accompanied him were equally surprised. True enough, the Scandinavian tour was not burdened with pressing political issues. It was mainly an expression of mutual good-will. But the forging of personal relations between leading statesmen of friendly countries can in itself become a political asset in time of need. This was perhaps best expressed by Iceland's Prime Minister Olafur Thors who said that "although there are no outstanding problems between our countries at the moment, I shall always remember your Prime Minister's face when Israel needs our assistance and understanding on the international scene."

But the easy-going, kind and human Ben-Gurion is rarely visible at home, above the mounting domestic and foreign problems that face the Prime Minister day by day. The man who has directed Israel's political life for so many years appears to the public mainly at formal functions. The press sees him mainly at off-the-record talks, hardly ever making it possible to face him in personal contact, putting a question and getting an answer, even if the issue is delicate. Ben-Gurion earned enthusiastic applause at Copenhagen's Danish Students Union auditorium while replying to Arab students on the refugee issue and Military Government.

Mr. Ben-Gurion gives the clear impression that he intends to remain at the helm for some time to come, while there are some major tasks to tackle.

### New Year Objective

It seems that this year he is to consider the question of mass education in all its aspects. This in itself may prove to be a major financial and social undertaking. Then there will be, of course, both immediate and long-range security problems, with the main emphasis on maintaining Israel's deterrent power to avoid open warfare in the Middle East.

**Remarks,** — The prophet Jeremiah in pre-announcing the conditions of this time when Israel is restored to their home land says, "Their nobles shall be of themselves, and their governor shall proceed from the midst of them: and I will cause him to draw near, and he shall approach unto me." Read Jeremiah 30:18 to 24.

Our Primeminister David Ben-Gurion, and our President are both Bible minded men, and men of prayer. They are the very nobles mentioned by this prophet here, and men of destiny, fore-ordained to lead Israel at this time of world crisis. Verses 23, 24 further establish these facts, for the whirlwind of war is to follow these days with continuous fury, which the prophet says is in the latter days. — Editor.
