

To the People Whom it Concerns, as had been announced a general meeting of The Church of God in Oregon. This Meeting convened as per announced Jan. 31 1934 at S. A. Oberg's home in Deven.

The following is a report of the meeting.

At a meeting in the home of S.A. Oberg, this morning the following motion was carried moved by S.A. Oberg that the Church of God in the State of Ore. [Oregon] accept the Constitution of the Organisation with headquarters at Salem West Virginia in its entire 40 points. Seconded by Brother Hobbs. Unanimously adopted or carried in view of the fact that only a minority of the Churches of God in Oregon were represented at this meeting. Nevertheless we who were assembled were unanimous in this acceptance of the constitution as a whole and whereas, it is necessary that the entire body of The Church of God in Oregon express its mind.

We therefore affix our names to this important document and send it forth to our other Brethren and sisters for the signatures of all who are with us and willing to go one hundred percent with the new Organization headquarters at Jerusalem [and] local headquarters at Salem West Virginia.

There were nine present at the meeting. This system does away with the old order of doing business so let all carefully read the Constitution and sign, and all tithes and offerings are to be sent direct to Salem W. Virginia or each local bod may for convenience choose a local Treasurer and this person send the totals to Salem W. Virginia. This is getting down to the Bible System [to] bring tithes and offerings into the store house of God.
