Dear Ted:

Let me at this time add that I have had no intention of causing you to live "as a vagabond," after having been accustomed to living in two of the finest homes. Thus enjoying the benefits of what you have called lavish and wanton extravagance in buying homes for top-ranking ministers. You seem to have forgotten, 1) that you have had the two finest, and 2) that I have admitted that we may have been over generous in supplying top executives with good middle-class homes, and have already sold most of them.

I have fully intended that, in lieu of the years that you devoted to the Work, regardless of the unhappy performance especially since 1973, we would see that you have a home in the place of your choice (but not in either Pasadena or Big Sandy) of quality, comparable to what you have had, in whatever manner is not in violation of IRS regulations, worked out with a retirement income we have been prepared to extend.

However, we will not in any manner continue to pay you to fight the Church or the Work. If you intend to fight and in any way continue to cause division, then all retirement compensation ceases immediately. Fighting the Worldwide Church of God now is going to cost you everything we would be prepared generously to arrange with you.
