I am researching on how to convert them to searchable high speed PDF documents. Will share as I can get the project going. God opened an unusual back door to acquire these documents. I followed a lead in an SDA publication and the author told us that these documents did not exist. They did, and with the help of a couple of people, we, unknown to the SDAs, now have beautiful copies.

NB: Most of the old periodicals (1800s) were supplied by Michael Germano in JPEG format (obtained from a Seventh-day Adventist contact who had secretly photographed them!). In mid-2018 Clayton Porter assisted me for weeks in assembling these 1,000s of pages. We had to take individual pages and combine them together into single files to complete a given issue of the periodical. Then labelling them followed by uploading to the site. This meant that most CG7 periodicals for the late 1800s were now preserved for posterity.

But in early 2024, John Lemley and Rose Difley were instrumental in locating the microfiche with these and more on them which were subsequently sent to John who arranged to have them converted to searchable PDF format. John and I had been seeking these for years and praying about it. Then all of a sudden Rose was told about them by someone at Church of God (Seventh Day) and the rest is history. Quite remarkable.
