

The primary commission Jesus Christ gave his Church is not to proclaim an urgent message about the forming of the beast of Revelation in Europe. You will simply not find such a commission given by Christ in the Bible. It is true that we focused on that very strongly for a good number of years. But, as God's people, let's not get our zeal about prophecy confused with our God-given commission. To do the Work is to fulfill the commission. It is not to shake people up about the timing of the appearance of the beast.

Very few of our modern ministers ever speak about Jesus' return. Most of those who do preach on this subject often bring discredit on themselves and their message by making startling statements to frighten people, or by setting exact dates for certain events for which they have no Biblical basis whatever.

The PLAIN TRUTH May 1954

These terrifying world-shaking events will take place in less than thirty years—in your life time, this very last generation that is destined to live in two worlds!

The PLAIN TRUTH September 1955

It is time we recognized that civilization has not more than 15 years to go unless a supernatural God in Heaven intervenes on earth to stop mad men from destroying all life on earth in their crazed dreams for world conquest.

God has led us to see that the purpose of prophecy is to guide us to him as the One who supervises the course of history, to remind us that he is Judge of all and that his judgment is surely coming, to assure us of his love, mercy, faithfulness and justice, as well as to encourage us and to reassure us that our faith is not in vain. It should be a motivation to faithful living, not to empty speculation.

Therefore, instead of heralding recent world events as the sure sign of the end, the Church points to the dangerous direction this world is going, to the prophecies of coming judgment on all nations, and to the promise of the return of Jesus Christ. The Church has encouraged the brethren to remain faithful to their calling in Christ for the rest of their lives, regardless of how many more wars, famines, epidemics, earthquakes, economic collapses or national disasters may occur before Jesus returns.

Do we believe that God's word is not true unless we see some tangible "proof" of fulfilled prophecy on the world scene? Do we need scare tactics, like some modern, would-be prophets use, to keep us excited about the wonderful truth of God's message? The answer is, of course, no! Not if we are truly the people of God.

I told you it could happen in the 1980s, or 1990s. Now I tell you it COULD (I do not yet say will) happen in a year! I would not be surprised to see it beginning to go together before the end of this year.

Fifteen years ago I thought our Work might be finished by 1972. But God seemed to DELAY the end of this present world by eight or ten years. But now the prophesied events indicate we are at the time of Romans 9:28: "For He will finish the work, and cut it short in righteousness; because a short work will the Lord make upon the earth."

Semi-Annual Letter, June 1980

We should preach prophecy correctly, emphasizing the reality of the return of Christ and the coming judgment. We should point to unstable and ungodly world conditions as a prod to remain close to God and to make our calling and election sure. We should preach continually about the return of Christ with eager anticipation.

But we should not claim to know something that is, in reality, only speculation and opinion and then use Scripture to support our view.
