


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

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Our purpose and desire is to foster Biblical, historical and related studies that strengthen the Church of God's message & mission and provides further support to its traditional doctrinal positions.

Introduction

My uncle, Ron Martin, my Mother's brother (1931-1996), mentioned the subject of German origins when I was a kid. He also alerted me to the author Greenberry Rupert (1847-1922) from time-to-time in conversation. Uncle Ron used to receive the *Plain Truth* magazine and subscribed to many of its teachings such as the Israel Message and identity of Assyria. I recall especially one of the occasions his mentioning Rupert. He urged me to look up his books at the local library. Alas, upon inquiring at the library, I was told that the books had been withdrawn from circulation. But after migrating to Australia via England, I was able to procure one of Rupert's books and a number of his booklets which I ordered from the USA. Unfortunately, these works contained no information on German origins and I continued my own research relentlessly.

There was one conversation I had with my uncle Ron Martin clear back in the early 1970s that stands out: I had read the book *The United States and British Commonwealth in Prophecy* but did not fully understand the prophecies about the various nations which would be raised up by God to come against the Anglo-Saxon-Keltic powers. He explained to me it would be Germany – or a German-led grouping and not Russia or the forces described so vividly in Ezekiel 38 & 39. He reasoned that a German-led Europe, not Russia, would be the major opponent of the Anglo-Saxon-Keltic nations in these last days. The Germans descended from the Assyrians he asserted.²

In reading some old British-Israel books available at the local public library I noticed that a couple of them referred to the Assyrian nature of the Germans with one demonstrating similarities between Germany's aggression against France in the eighteenth century and the Assyrian nature. ³ As a young school student I could not fathom the possibility of identifying the origin of the Germans, since it seemed that no historian and no academic text would even vaguely make a reference to an Assyrian or other Biblical connection. Nevertheless I was intrigued for it had a 'ring of truth' to it and I could see how a revived and aggressive Germany could arise again someday. Upon undertaking some research that I was able to at that age, there was little proof available – although there were some striking similarities between the Germans and Assyrians that stood out.

Later I was privileged to read Dr Herman Hoeh's two-part series titled "Germany in Prophecy" which had been serialised in the *Plain Truth* magazine in 1962-63 (based on an earlier 1958 Plain Truth article "What's Behind the Arab Crisis?") and which evidently was built upon the broad parameters of earlier researchers.⁴ Still later I read volume two of his *Compendium of World History* which included two chapters on the subject.

I decided that there must be more proof than this available to the serious researcher. These works contained the foundations for further study and the theory fitted well into history and prophecy. From

the mid 1970s I commenced keeping notes on this and other subjects and entire chapters were written from the late 1970s into the early 1980s. They were assembled into a manuscript on national origins that was due to the published in 1986. But intense ongoing harassment and jealousy over an extended period of years prevented this from happening. Instead, I published parts of the book over several years. One of these was my research on German origins titled *The Assyrians in the Modern World* (1990) which was republished and updated in 1994 under the title *Who are the Germans?* Later, in 2003, the original manuscript was published under the title *In Search of ... the Origin of Nations* which included some of the information contained herein.

In 2006 the above small book was expanded and published as *The Great German Nation*. *Origins and Destiny*.

"Now I, a Dane, writing of the danger of Germanism, cannot deny myself the pleasure of stating that, long before anyone else, a Dane, one of our greatest, the poet and Church dignitary, N. F. S. Grundtvig (d. 1872) foresaw and foretold the danger. As early as 1838 he wrote that Europe ought to rejoice in the fact that Germany was still split up into small states. " For if one were to picture all the heads that think and speak German gathered under one hat, then one would picture a German Napoleon, a power more terrible in human eyes than France in her most dangerous hour. And, to my mind, it follows that the Germans would be the more tyrannical masters because they take things so much more seriously and thoroughly. That such a political federation, uniting all forces to form one huge German engine of war, would not be less disastrous to all that is good in Germany itself than to the rest of the world, is quite obvious, and this danger threatens Europe and Germany rather from the military state of Prussia than from the universities of Germany. A state having a common speech, stretching from the Baltic to the Mediterranean, from the Vistula to beyond the Rhine, animated by the German military spirit, intelligence, and pride, would under its Napoleon, its war-god, impose upon the world the heaviest chains it has yet borne." (Prof J. P. Bang, "The Root of the Matter," The Hibbert Journal, Vol. 15, No. 1, 1916, p. 14) [emphasis mine]

Origin of the Doctrine

It is difficult to know when the understanding of German origins first came to the fore. It seems to have been something that many British-Israelites became aware of after discovering who the Israelites were. From there it is deductive reasoning based on physical appearance, mental attributes, tribal names and comparison of the promises and blessings listed in Genesis 49 and elsewhere with the nations of Europe.

In terms of physical anthropology and human biology, the north-west Europeans (Nordics and Kelts) would be Israelites. The north-eastern peoples (Prussians, Balts, Northwest Ukrainians) would represent descendants of Abraham through Keturah.

Here are some early advocates for this truth:

Famous British-Israel author of the nineteenth century, Hine (1874), wrote:

"We have long held the Germans to be identical with the Assyrians; and shall be prepared, in due course, if no one in the meantime will take this matter in hand, to come forward ourselves with proofs." (Forty-seven Identifications of the British Nation with the Lost Ten Tribes, p. 54)

Hine (1870s) again excludes the Teutonic race from being Israelites in an article "The Teutonic Theory", Life from the Dead, Vol. 1, p. 327 quoted in "And I Shall Make Thee A Great Nation..." Anglo-Israelism and the Quest for a Racial Theology of Empire, p. 27 by Tara Teeter.

Another renowned British-Israel author, John Wilson likewise "espoused the idea that the Germans were the modern Assyrian peoples, the constant enemy of the Israelites" (p. 27) in "The Assyrians," *Life from the Dead*, Vol. 1, p. 337 (1870s). He is famous for *Our Israelitish Origin*, 1851. The first edition was 1840.

In Discourse XVII, of *The Lost Ten Tribes* (1882), Joseph Wild subtly likens the Prussians to the Assyrians.⁵

One old British-Israel World Federation book stated: "Prussians, a modern people, in the writer's opinion (expressed before war) of an Assyrian stock." (B de Weldon, *The Origin of the English*, 1900, p. 284). However, the author offered no proof.

Eric Reisenauer in his PhD thesis, *British-Israel: Racial Identity in Imperial Britain, 1870-1920*, provides further sources:

"During the war, interest in the Identity increased markedly. British-Israelites had long predicted that there would be a collision between the English and Germans, whom many considered to be descendants of Assyria. A few years before the war, the German Dr. Swaner, editor of the newspaper *Der Volkserzieher*, stated that, "it will not be surprising to find that England is found to be identified with Israel, and that Germany is a mixture of the Philistines, Assyrians, and Romans--traditional enemies of Israel." [116]" (p.234. Footnote 116: "Quoted in "Prophecy and Diplomacy," *The Truth* (Mizpah, Jerusalem), 18 October 1910.") "

"This ethnological makeup, he continued, explained the animosity between the Germans and Anglo-Saxons." (ibid)

"Diplomatic and political concerns, however, are always in a state of flux. As Germany replaced Russia as the focus of concern in the area, the British-Israel interpretation of Eastern events had to make appropriate adjustments. Commander Roberts suggested that Russia and Germany would form a confederacy against Israel, the one as Prince of Rosh the other as Assyria, thus reviving an old British-Israel idea of Germans as descendants of the Assyrians. [93]" (p. 388. Footnote 93: "Rev. L. G.

A. Roberts, *Israel in the Book of Revelation* (London: R. Banks and Son, 1911), 196-98.")

Another I came across is Marr Murray (1915) in his book Bible Prophecies and the Plain Man

"As it was in the case of the Israelites and Assyrians, so it is in that of Britain and Germany. The fact that one people enjoys the protection of a Special Providence has aroused a virulent hatred in the breast of the other. In the history of Britain, no less than in the history of Israel, the workings of a special Providence are to be seen, and, as of old, it has roused the enmity and jealousy of less favoured rivals.

It is significant, too, that to accomplish the ambition of crushing Britain, Germany has deserted Christ and reverted to the old gods of the Assyrians. The doctrines of Nietzsche, Treitschke and Bernhardi, whose writings have displaced the Bible to all practical intents and purposes in modern Germany, are the doctrines of Baal, the old god of blood and fire and frightfulness.

There is now the question whether this similarity between Israel and Assyria, on the one hand, and Britain and Germany on the other, is a mere coincidence or the fulfilment of prophecy." (p. 89).

He devotes the entirety of chapter 10 to the subject.

"...in that year [1917] General Edmund Allenby made increasing advances in the Middle East and on December 11, he formally took possession of Jerusalem, the capital of the Kingdom of Judah.123 Could it be, British-Israelites asked eagerly, that this was all coincidence? These events, without a doubt, provoked many to look into their case. The *Daily Chronicle*, certainly not a British-Israel organ, reported that "the victories of General Allenby in Palestine have given a new interest to what is called 'British Israelism.' The late Queen Victoria was profoundly impressed by some of these ideas and studied a chart which set out to prove that we were the direct inheritors of the Israelite tradition." [124]" (Reisenauer, ibid, p. 237. Footnote 124: *Daily Chronicle* (London), 11 November 1917.)

In a book on the history of British-Israelism titled *Israelism in Britain*, Aiden Cottrell-Boyce notes that many British-Israelites believed that the Germans were Assyrians. He mentions a consensus that grew during WW1 taking on this position:

"the Germans in many respects, are very like what the Assyrians were We have Assyrian cruelty and German cruelty. Since the opening of this fearful war, the Germans have been revealed to us as a remarkably cruel and ruthless people." (Cottrell-Boyce, p. 199, quoting Ernest Jordan, *The Banner of Israel*, Vol. 42, No. 2,152 (27 March 1918), p. 120)

During the last years of WW1, some believed that the Germans and Russians were 'Babylonian Assyrians.' (p. 181 quoting *The Banner of Israel*, Vol. 43, No. 2,207 (16 April 1919), p. 139) and 'Assyria, after Babylon, is Israel's last enemy.' (Cottrell-Boyce, ibid, p. 181, quoting *The Banner of Israel*, Vol. 43, No. 2,193 (8 Jan 1919), p. 19.

"'Assyrians are generally accepted as the Teutonic people of Europe,' wrote another in the following year." (Cottrell-Boyce, ibid, p. 199, quoting *The Banner of Israel*, Vol. 43, No. 2,207 (16 April 1919), p.139)

In January 1920 at a lecture on British-Israelism, it was proposed that the Germans were not Israelites (Cottrell-Boyce, ibid, pp. 30-31 referring to *The Banner of Israel*, Vol. 44, No. 2,245 (7 Jan 1920), p. 12.)

Llwellyn Thomas in *God and My Birthright* (1919), quotes a Dr Swaner as stating that many Germans descend from the Assyrians (Cottrell-Boyce, ibid, p. 94).

Mackendrick (1921) wrote:

"The hatred of Prussian Germany against God's chosen people, Israel (the Anglo-Saxon-Celts), dates from the time they took Hebrew Israel captive 720 years before Christ, so 'tis fairly well ingrained." (*The Destiny of The British Empire and the U.S.A.*, p. 186)

Notice, he recognizes this as an ingrained trait. Some would term this "racial memory" which was explored previously in the book. On page 187 he calls the Prussians "Assyrians" and "Huns" while on page 6 he states:

"At that time the Assyrians cut down Israel's vines and fruit trees, a thing forbidden in the Bible. Prussia is modern Assyria, and when the Huns retired to the Hindenburg line in the spring of 1917, they ran true to type. In the Bapaume sector they cut down every vine and fruit tree in every French garden for fifty miles, and many of these trees came out in bloom later as they lay murdered on the ground ... Germany was out to maim France for life, and their poisoning wells and murdering fruit trees was a small item in the long list of barbarities and willful premeditated destructions."

Gayer, author of *The Heritage of the Anglo-Saxon Race* (1941) also sees the true origins of the Germans:

"It is startling that the modern Germans are the descendants of migrants who originally came into Europe from Asia about the beginning of the Christian era from that part which framed the ancient empire of Assyria.

In modern Germany we witness the same attitude towards us as the Assyrians of old displayed towards the Israelites." (p. 72)

Another, Cox (1942), wrote:

"It is thought by many that those of the ruling class of Prussia are directly descended from the Assyrians of old, and this seems highly possible when one remembers that Assyria was the parent of the Babylonian succession of empires, all dominated by military force, referred to in scriptural symbology as the Beast." (*Nations in*

Prophecy, p. 15)

Plant (1945) wrote that "Ancient Assyria is Germany and Russia is ... Rosh, Mesech and Tubal." (*The Japanese. Who Are They?* p. ii)

Henking (1960) mentions that the Assyrians are the Prussians and East Germans (*God's Continuing Kingdom*, p. 22).

Researcher Dr. Pilkey in his work *Origins of Nations* (1984) declares that many Germans descend from the Assyrians.

In his booklet *Nations in Prophecy,* Dr. Court (1986) attempts to prove that the Assyrians are today's Prussians:

"A German writer, Dr. Swanor, one-time editor of the German paper 'Volkeer-zieher', traced with extraordinary lucidity the origins of various ancient tribes and races including the various Canaanite peoples. According to his simple but profound researches ... he concludes that Germany is a mixture of Philistines, Assyrians and Romans, the traditional enemies of Israel." (*Daily Mail*, 5th May, 1910) (p. 7)

R.N. Stuart, author of the *Races of Mankind* chart shows Assyria as including Germany, Prussia and Russia. And a chart by another author (unnamed) may be found on page 27 where Prussia is identified as Assur.

The famous television commentator, Glenn Beck also subscribes to it:

"What's interesting is the Assyrians who were very good, meticulous record keepers, and who were just brutal, they settled in Italy and in the Germany area and the Russian area where Fascism comes from. But the Israelites, the lost ten tribes, they went north, and they started to scatter the other direction, and they went to the coastlines, generally in the area where our pilgrims came from. Judah kept the Torah alive. Those who were taken captive by the Assyrians, Caucasians over the mountains, and they started to populate the western part of Europe. All of Western civilization is based on the laws of Israel. And our entire history is directly tied to this moment. Our pilgrims thought that they were completing the journey out of captivity from Moses." (Glenn Beck, Why Do I Care about the Middle East? 8 Aug 2013 (www.glennbeck.com/2013/08/07/glennwhydoicareaboutthemiddleeast/)

Even non-British-Israelites have referred to the similarity of Assyrians to Germans.

Historian Waddell (1929) traces the Hittites from Anatolia to Germany (especially the Chatti tribe), although he does not equate the Assyrians with the Germans (*The Makers of Civilization*, p. 471).

Jerome of Stridon wrote the following some time around 400AD:

"He that lets is taken out of the way, and yet we do not realize that Antichrist is near. Yes, Antichrist is near...The whole country between the Alps and the Pyrenees, between the Rhine and the Ocean, has been laid waste by hordes of Quadi, Vandals, Sarmatians, Alans, Gepids, Herules, Saxons, Burgundians, Allemanni and—alas! For

the commonweal!— even Pannonians. For Assur also is joined with them. The once noble city of Moguntiacum has been captured and destroyed. In its church many thousands have been massacred. The people of Vangium after standing a long siege have been extirpated. The powerful city of Rheims, the Ambiani, the Altrebatæ, the Belgians on the skirts of the world, Tournay, Spires, and Strasburg have fallen to Germany: while the provinces of Aquitaine and of the Nine Nations, of Lyons and of Narbonne are with the exception of a few cities one universal scene of desolation." (Jerome. Letter CXXIII to Ageruchia, Chapter 16. From Nicene and Post-Nicene Fathers, Second Series, Vol. 6. Edited by Philip Schaff and Henry Wace. (Christian Literature Publishing Co, Buffalo, NY, 1893).

Whether Jerome meant this literally or metaphorically is open to argument, but the former is likely.

Another is Sargon Dadesho who made a YouTube video: *Germans are descendants of the Assyrian people* https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=6GJnAQP8wao

"The origin of the German people. Assyrian tribes immigrated to Europe before the fall of Assyria. Ab-Ram (Ibrahim) came from Assyria's land of Shameru (UR). Ab-Ram's grandchild (Ashurum) was sent back to Assyria."

Lewis Paton, a professor at Hartford Theological Seminary wrote an entire article (1916) published in a scholarly journal drawing many parallels between Prussians and Assyrians:

"History repeats itself, and whenever conditions arise in one age that resemble those in a previous age there is reason to believe that the outcome in both cases will be similar." ("Assyria and Prussia," *The Hibbert Journal*, Vol. 15, No. 1, p. 97)⁸

The entire article is worth a read.

Even Jacques Ellul (1916), the famous Christian philosopher, Professor of Law and Sociology and History of Institutions at the University of Bordeaux, drew parallels between Assyria and Germany (in his time he wrote almost 40 books and published several hundred articles). In *The Politics of God and the Politics of Man* he wrote:

"In other words, even if the Assyrian is in effect the scourge of God, does this mean that to fight against him is to fight against God? The argument is often heard that misery is a test imposed by God and so the wretches who suffer it must not revolt. Hitler is God's scourge and so he must not be resisted. We hear the same today regarding communism. What we forget is that in such matters God's aim is not a political one. The point is not at all that **Assyria or Germany** should become a great nation, nor that the economic system should be socialist. God uses the Assyrian in order that his people should really become his people again in truth, in humility, in

sanctity, in authenticity. What happens has to do with Israel or the church, and not the state or capitalism or socialism. To repent and to accept the punishment does not at all imply passivity. Once God's intention is perceived and accepted, then in faith, and in virtue of faith, there is need, politically, to act against the one who shows himself to be God's enemy." (chapter 6 "Rabshakeh") [emphasis mine]

There are others such as an online sermon by Kevin Jordan, Three Village Church, *The Relentless Pursuit of God: Messages from the Book of Jonah. Message 4: Large Love* (The sermon is located at www.3vc.org/sermon%20pdfs/Jonah%204.pdf)

"Now, at this level, it's not hard to sympathize with Jonah. Remember who the Ninevites were? They were citizens of the capital city of Assyria, the Nazi Germany of its day. The Assyrians took great delight in conquering other weaker nations, and they were notorious for the vicious and brutal treatment of those they conquered."

While not stating or believing that the Germans descend from the ancient Assyrians, he at least sees some metaphorical similarity between the Nazis and the Assyrians. The similarity is just too close to miss.

Others feel that the Assyrians migrated elsewhere. One theory is that they migrated into Russia. For example A.J. Ferris in *The Assyrian in Bible Prophecy* (1950) claims the Assyrians are in Russia today! Rather, they moved through Russia and into Central Europe, a point he does not see.

Other theories (without any proof whatsoever – I know as I have read them all) includes includes: Gomer, Edom, Judah, Simeon, Gad etc.

"Empires do not last for ever, but it has been observed that the successful Assyrian Empire served as a model for a number of subsequent ones, notably the Persian and Roman Empires." (Chris Allen, What distinguishes the Neo Assyrian Empire from its predecessors in the Ancient Near East?, p. 6) [emphasis mine]

Acceptance of German Identity in the Radio/Worldwide Church of God

Herbert Armstrong originally held the view that the Germans descended from Gomer (see "What is going to happen?", *Plain Truth*, June-July 1934, p. 6). Yet by the early 1950's, he changed to accept the proven Assyrian origin of the Germans. This was probably due to the influence of Herman Hoeh who commenced indepth research into British-Israelism and also brought some additional proofs for other existing doctrines. That is why he is sometimes called 'an architect of Worldwide Church of God doctrines' in the 1950s and into the mid-1960s.

In chapter 5 of Mystery of Ages Mr Armstrong wrote:

"The Assyrians settled in central Europe, and the Germans, undoubtedly, are, in part, the descendants of the ancient Assyrians." (p. 183).

Mr Armstrong mentioned the truth about German origins in his various editions of his book *The United States and Britain in Prophecy* with millions published and circulated. It was he who had popularised this belief by distributing millions of copies of this book. In *The United States and Britain in Prophecy*, 1980 edition he also demonstrated his belief in this:

"The Assyrians—before 604 B.C.—left their land north of Babylon and migrated northwest—through the lands that are now Georgia, the Ukraine, Poland, and into the land that is called GERMANY today. Today the descendants of those Assyrians are known to us as the GERMAN people. (pp. 143-144)

"That YOKE of SLAVERY without mercy is to be laid on the U.S. and Britain by the coming united nations of Europe! It has started already, through the economic Common Market and the recently implemented EMS (European Monetary System)...

The prophecy does not literally say so, but in all probability, by present indications, the head of this new WORLD POWER will be in central Europe. And it will precipitate World War III. And this time it will be allowed to succeed!

Many of the ancient Assyrians migrated NORTHWEST from their ancient land south of the Caspian Sea and settled in central Europe, just as the House of Israel migrated from the land of their captivity to the coastlands of northwest Europe. So when you read about Assyria in prophecies pertaining to NOW, they refer to central Europe.

So, history is to repeat! It was ancient Assyria which invaded the House of Israel, and carried them out of Samaria into the Assyrian's own land." (p. 174)

Herman Hoeh's research was published in the *Plain Truth*: "Truth about the Race Question," *Plain Truth*, July 1957, pp. 7-8; "What's Behind the Arab Crisis? *Plain Truth*, Sept 1958, pp. 33-6, 12-18, 23-24; "Germany in Prophecy," *Plain Truth*, Dec 1962, pp. 25-27; "Germany in Prophecy," *Plain Truth*, Jan 1963, pp. 15-17, 27-30.

There is no doubt that he received assistance from others with this research. For example Ernest Martin provided some further insights in a letter to Dr Hoeh dated 23 March 1961 pages 11-12. Although the letter concerned Hebrew calendar research, it included some information on German-Assyrian connections in the final two pages.

Keith Stump similarly wrote a memo to Dr Hoeh concerning further information in relation to the *Austrian Chronicle* (13 May 1987).

Dr Hoeh also authored *Compendium of World History*. Volume 2 contains two chapters ("Early History of Germany" and "The Ancient Kings of the Germans") dedicated to the Assyrian origin of the Germans. This is probably the first time ever that the subject had been broached in such a public manner and some proofs presented. Prior to that, proofs had been flimsy, although the theory made sense. Indeed, Herman Hoeh's contribution was a major addition to this belief, building upon predecessors in partial fulfillment of the prophecy in Daniel 12:4. However, even his articles contained

errors and needed to be beefed up for a modern audience and critical eyes.

Herman L Hoeh who would have seen the few British-Israelite comments on this per those referred to earlier in this article. It is also obvious that he read the works of Laurence Austine Waddell, a non-British-Israelite who understood that the White Hittites (not to be confused with the Canaanite Hittites, descendants of Heth), found their way into Europe.

From there this belief seeped into articles and sermons scattered throughout the Worldwide Church of God's literature with the two-part *Plain Truth* series being made available as a reprint stand-alone article. But after Dr Hoeh withdrew the *Compendium of World History* due to errors, so was this article. My understanding is that the article was to be updated, but never was. However, the doctrine continued on until it was gradually and subtly dropped by the successors to Herbert W Armstrong. Eventually, the Worldwide Church of God made it obvious that it was dumped completely, though it took them some time to come out openly about it:

Concerning the World Tomorrow telecast Joseph Tkach, the successor to Herbert Armstrong wrote:

"Prophecy programs will not highlight which individual, which nation or which group of nations currently may be fulfilling specific end-time prophecies. Prophecy programs will present a balanced, overall perspective of the purpose and value of prophecy, instead of attempting to interpret specific prophecies.

"Prophecy programs will not lose sight of the gospel message by trading the true gospel for a 10-nation / save-your-skin' gospel (Galatians 1:6-10). This was never the gospel. It was an interesting 'hook' to get people interested in the true gospel." ("Personal from Joseph W. Tkach," *Worldwide News*, 19 Nov 1990, p. 5)

"Fear is a powerful motivator, even getting results when the threat is exceedingly remote. It makes us cross at crosswalks even when traffic is thin, pay more over time for fire insurance than our homes are worth, and shy away from snakes even when signs clearly inform us they are not poisonous. Humans instinctively take steps to prevent negative outcomes, oftentimes regardless of how likely — or more to the point, unlikely — those unpleasant outcomes are...

Worrying about continental European countries sublimating their national differences, uniting into a federated superstate and invading the United Kingdom may seem to flirt with lunacy, but within that lingering concern lies the root of the Anglo-American alliance. Similarly, worrying about China using the archipelagos of Southeast Asia as a staging point for an invasion of Australia may seem ludicrous, but that fear dominates military planning in Canberra." Continuing this doctrine

Today many Church of God groups have continued this truth, publishing various books and articles on the subject. Among them are the following:

• The Living Church of God published *Germany in Prophecy* (2022); "A Clash of Eagles: America and Germany in Prophecy", *Tomorrow's World* (Sept-Oct 2002) and "The Return of Germany", *Tomorrow's World* (May-June 2006), both by Douglas Winnail; "Is the Beast Awakening?" by

Roderick C Meredith, *Tomorrow's World* (Sept-Oct 2000); and a study article topic "A Fourth Reich?" by Douglas Winnail.¹⁰

- Garner Ted Armstrong with the Church of God, International and later the Intercontinental Church of God, presented sermons and wrote articles where, in passing, he raised the subject. He certainly continued to believe in the Assyrian origin of the Germans.
- The United Church of God has mentioned it occasionally in literature and sermons.
- Church of the Eternal God published an article in 2006 on *Germany in Prophecy* (German language) and later a full booklet.¹¹
- The Philadelphia Church of God published booklets and articles that mentioned this truth:
 Germany and the Holy Roman Empire; Nahum: Prophecy for Germany; The Rising Beast; "A
 Mysterious Alliance" by Gerald Flurry, Philadelphia Trumpet (June 2003) in addition to articles
 by other writers such as The Remarkable Identity of the German People.

- Germany & Prophecy, Steven LeBlanc. World Watch Today c2020.

A number of other Church of God groups such as Christian Biblical Church of God, The Greater Church of God and others also teach this truth.

Today we enlarge upon the research of those statements from over 100 years ago and increase our knowledge and understanding of this and other topics (see Daniel 12:4).¹³

And to assist you with your own research and Bible studies, two appendices are contained at the rear of this document: List of Important Biblical References to the Assyrians and Assyria in Prophecy. Scriptures pertaining to Assyria in the Last Days.

"Their cities destroyed and their power shattered, **the Assyrians disappeared from history**, remembered only as a cruel people of the Old Testament who oppressed the Hebrews. Two hundred years later, when the Greek adventurer and historian Zenophon passed by the ruins of Nineveh, he marveled at their extent but knew nothing of the Assyrians. The glory

of their empire was forgotten" (John McKay, *A History of Western Society* (3rd ed.), p. 50. See also Lawrence Boadt, *Reading the Old Testament*, p. 44) [emphasis mine]

Concluding Remarks

God works in mysterious ways, does He not? Normally it appears that He works quietly and subtly to bring about His will. Other times rather confrontationally which is frightening.

He has been restoring Truth since the mid-1800s, sowing the seeds for doctrines such as British-Israelism and the identity of Germany, inspiring research, watering the seeds, growing this Truth into a great tree and pruning the branches as we fine-tune and purify what we have learned.

In other words, we need to refresh our research and fix whatever minor problems there may be with the doctrine. But the essence and most details are not in error.

My own book *The Great German Nation. Origins and Destiny* will be updated in due course but with some minor calibration. Much more evidence will be included in the updated version of the book.

In any discussion of Assyria/Germany in prophecy, it must be explained to the reader that Assyria incorporates more than the direct descendants of Assur who reside in Bavaria, Austria and from whom two thirds of Swiss derive. Assyria is therefore likely to be a synecdoche (part for the whole). The eastern/Prussian (Hittite) element descend from Assur, great-grandson of Abraham via Keturah; northwest Germans are Aramaeans and Schwabians descend from Sheba, a grandson of Abraham, also via Keturah. They are all similar anyway and have intermarried to some degree.

In all of this, Daniel 12:4 comes to mind in the wider Church of God context and is so relevant to us during these days:

"But you, Daniel, shut up the words and seal the book, until the time of the end. Many shall run to and fro, and **knowledge shall increase**." (ESV)

This is now an unstoppable doctrine and truth found within so many groups, even though they are scattered and weak. But at least they are getting the message out there.

May we protect this truth as it comes under renewed attack and strive to find ever more evidence for it.
