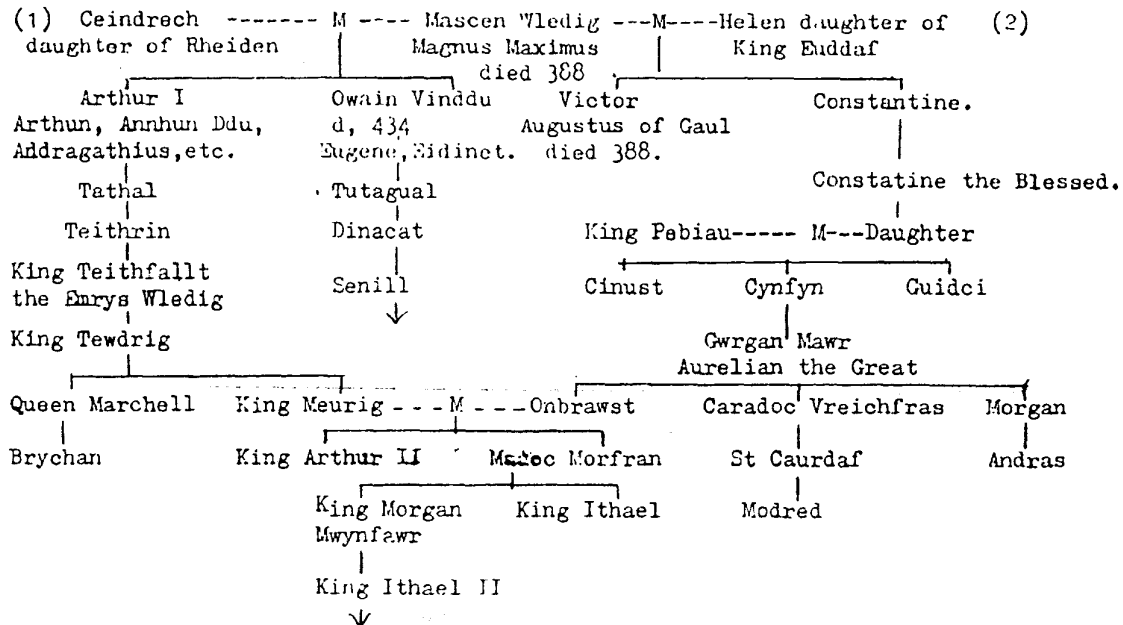


The Arthurian Dynasty.

As exhibited in the British Museum Vespasian A XIV, Harleian 4081, 4181, and other sources.



1. Tathal, also recorded as Thathal and as Teudfal and as "Theodore", is probably the Tewdur Mawr whose giant grave mound stands on Mynydd Islwyn.
2. Owain Vinddu is buried in his grave mound at Llanhileth alongside St Illtyd's church, as in the Songs of the graves.
3. Teithrin is named on an ancient stone in Brecon.
4. King Teithfallt is the Emrys Wledig also known as Tudfwlch, he is highly likely the Saint buried at Llandyfodwch, where an effigy stone lies. His accession stone exists, as do records of his accession. He married Dwyanned daughter of Amlodd.
5. King Tewdrig buried at Mathern, twice excavated in 1609 and 1881, was an Uthyrpen-dragon, and he married St Govein, buried at her Chapel, excavated in 1920's.
6. Queen Marchell married Enlech Coronog who is buried - "ante hostium ecclesie Llanyspydyt" (also spelled Lanespetit.). Genealogy of Enlech well known, and he was father of St Teilo and St Medoc.
7. Arthur I son of Mascen lies buried at Oldbury in Atherston.
8. Arthur II son of Meurig lies buried at Caer Caradoc in the Cor mound.
9. King Meurig Uthyrpendragon lies buried in Llandaff Cathedral.
10. St Caurdaf's ruined Monastery still stands in the woods at Miskin.
11. The mound grave of Bedd Morgan Mwynfawr is in Southern Glamorgan.
12. King Ithael left a memorial stone at Llantwit Major = Llan-illtyd-fawr. King Tewdrig left an accession stone at Margam, King Arthur left a land grant stone at Merthyr Mawr.
13. from Senill descendant of Owain Fynddu - "Sir Gawaine" - descended Neithion, - Run(Rhun) - Tutacual - Anthec - Mermin - Anavaunt - Tutagual. etc.
14. The many descents from Ithael son of Morgan Mwynfawr, son of Madoc Morfran, son of King Meurig Uthyrpendragon, are copiously recorded and attested.
15. Constantine the Blessed is most probably buried in Warwickshire.

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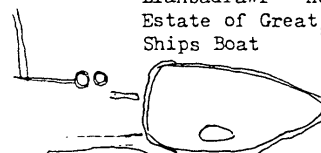

King Teithfallt around A.D.470.

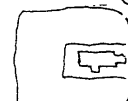

1. The massacre at the Peace Conference of around A.D.466 took place at Caer Caradoc - Caradoc's Castle.
2. Myrddyn Emrys met the Ambassadors of Vortigern at St Peters Church at Caer Caradoc.
3. Mynwent y Milwyr circular monument was built by Em-Rhys Wledig at Caer Caradoc around A.D.470 for the dead in the Saxon revolt.
4. An Uthyrpendragon was buried in the Giant Circle at Caer Caradoc in the late Sixth Century.

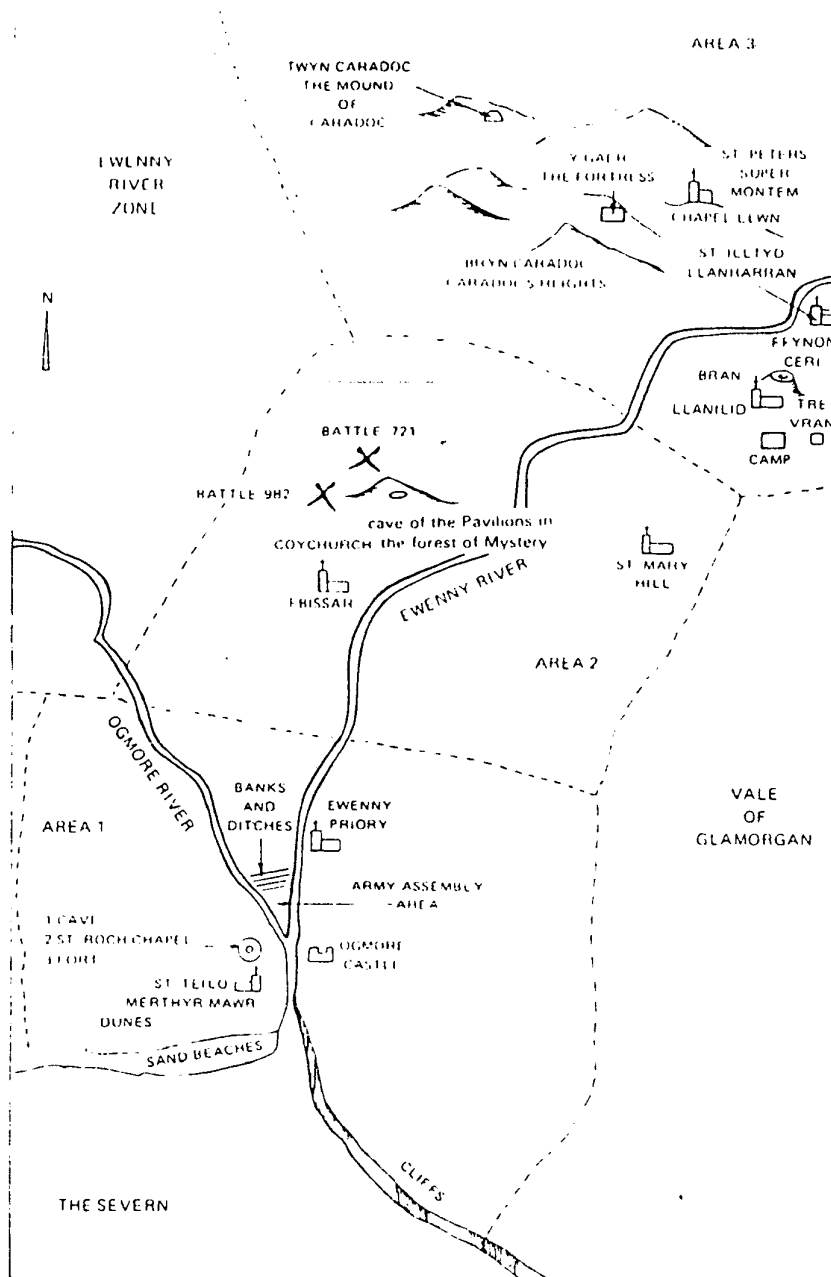

6. Llan Ilid the church of St Ilid =Gilead=Gallilean, chaplain to Bran a greatnephew of Caradoc I.

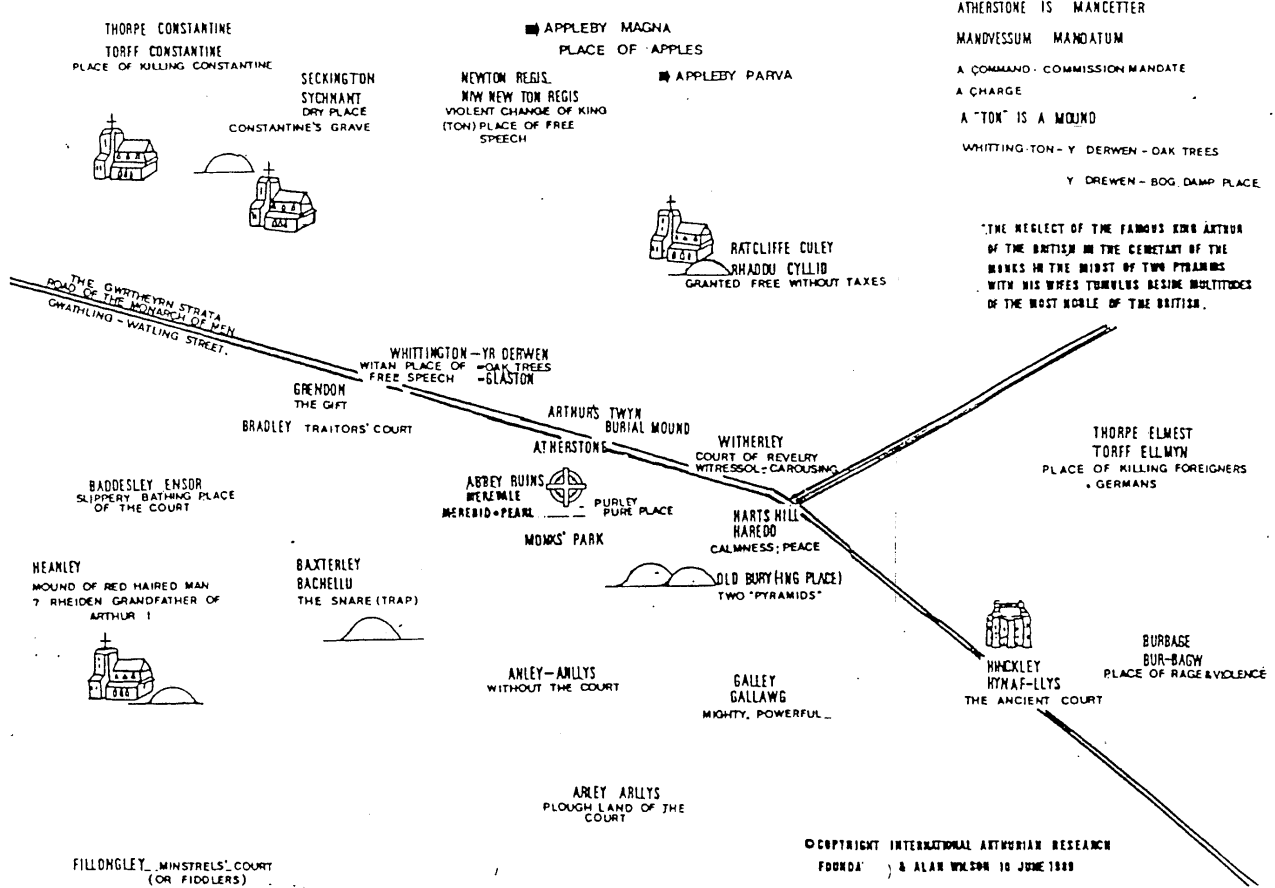
Schematic Diagram of the Important Sites and Monuments on the
